- 5. From your answer to question 4, give meanings and example of doing those things.
 - a. Humbling ourselves
 - b. Praying
 - c. Seeking him (other ways than praying)
- 6. What last thing does God want us to do? Give examples of how we do this individually and as a nation?
- 7. Why does God allow nations to suffer?
- 8. What promises does God give us in the end of verses 14? Why is this encouraging?
