CONFIRMATION:

Registration received by mail will be confirmed if you send a self-addressed stamped envelope. Registration received by phone and online will automatically receive a confirmation. If you do not receive a confirmation in 5 business days, call our office at (714) 480-7443. Non-receipt of confirmation does not warrant a refund.

REFUND & TRANSFER POLICY FOR ALL EVENTS:

Refund and transfer requests must be made (5) business days prior to the event less a \$15 processing fee per person. Day Tours: may be canceled up to 10 days prior to departure date less a \$15 processing fee. A refund will only be issued if your space can be re-sold. You may send a substitute in place. Multi Day Tours: Travel Protection insurance is highly recommended. A refund will be issued less a \$50 cancellation Fee. Non receipt of confirmation does not warrant a refund for any event.

RETURNED CHECKS & REFUNDS BY CHECK, CASH OR MONEY ORDER:

A \$25 Fee will be charged for any returned check. In addition, an administration hold placed against your student records and a class stop will be issued. Refunds issued for cash, check or money order transactions may take 4-5 weeks to process with a completed W-9 form.

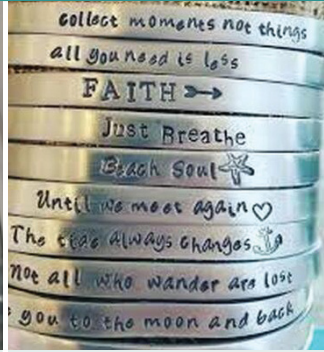

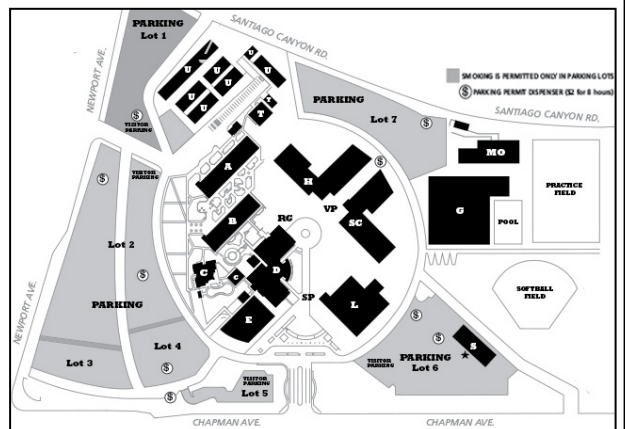
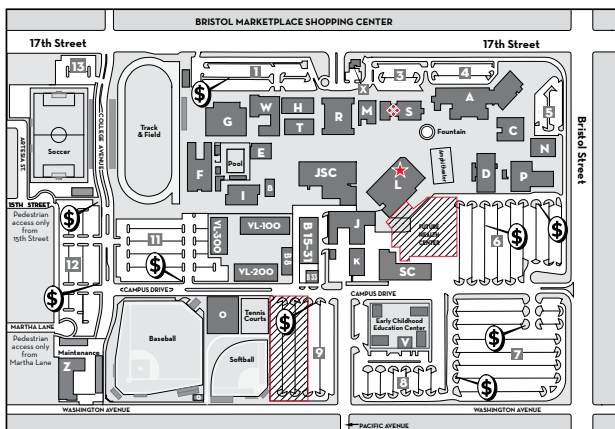
