 - 1. Connect a USB HDD to a USB port on your router.
 - 2. Launch ReadySHARE Vault.

- 5. (Optional) To rename the folder that your backup files will be save to, click the **Rename Backup Folder** link and do the following:
 - a. Click the Rename Backup Folder radio button.
 - **b.** In the **Backup Folder** field, enter a new name for the folder.
 - c. Click the Save button.
- 6. In the Select Files and Folder section, you can select all, or click check boxes to select specific files and folders on your computer that you want backed up to the HDD.



You can click one of the following options to view the folders and files on your computer:

- Click the Show More menu to view the main folders on your computer.
- Click the **Select Additional Files/Folder** link to view all the folders and files on your computer.
- 7. (Optional) In the Security section, if you want your backup to be password protected, select the **Enable Secure Data** check box.
