## **City of Birmingham Mayor's Office Division of Youth Services Launches the 2022 FOX 6 Kids & Jobs**



The City of Birmingham Mayor's Office Division of Youth Services (DYS), in partnership with WBRC FOX 6, launches the 2022 Kids & Jobs program. This summer, DYS and FOX 6 will put hundreds of Birmingham youth to work through this program. Kids & Jobs is designed to help cultivate the professional development necessary for youth and young adults to become an integral part of the workforce.

### **Components:**

- **EXPOSURE (14 & 15 Year-Old)**  
Participating students will receive first-time exposure to the workplace. The Exposure component of the Kids & Jobs program gives deserving Birmingham youth, who might otherwise not be given the chance, an opportunity to experience the workplace for the first time.
- **FUTURE EXECUTIVE (16-24 Year-Old)**  
The Future Executive component provides high school and college students ages 16 - 24 with an introduction to the workforce and a chance to explore one of the various professions offered.

Students who qualify for the program are provided with valuable work experience and our Program Partners gain much needed summer assistance.
