Emergency Template Instructions

Due to the site complexity of Tucson RMD sites, it is important to know exactly where you are in the instance of an emergency in order to route emergency personnel to your exact location.

For this reason, we are requiring that all construction sites post an emergency information sign, along with their POC construction signage, for use by anyone in the area in the instance of a medical or fire emergency that contains the site address, building number, and column number.

All emergency calls are all now routed through local 911 dispatch, but if calling from a cell phone they will not be able to determine your location and you must be able to provide detailed information regarding your exact location.

If there are site security concerns, Raytheon Dispatch should be called.
