SISTER DEIRDRE BYRNE

(affectionately known as Sister Dede) | The Heroes of my Life Led me to Our Lady

Sr. Deirdre Byrne is a missionary sister and superior of her community in Washington, DC. She is double board-certified in family medicine and general surgery. A native of the Washington, D.C., area, she is one of eight siblings. She graduated from Virginia Tech. After college, Sister Dede entered medical school at Georgetown University, where she completed a surgical residency. She also joined the Army. Sister Deirdre was led to the *Little Workers of the Sacred Hearts* community whose charism places each and every person between the Heart of Jesus and Mary. Her apostolate has been performing overseas medical missionary surgery and providing free medical care for the poor. Dr. Byrne made her commitment to the Little Workers and began her novitiate training in earnest. Sister Dede retired with the rank of Colonel from the United States Army after 29 years of service. She served alongside "brave soldiers" in Afghanistan. She has found it easy to integrate her medical and military service into her religious vocation. Right now she is the superior of the D.C. Little Workers of the Sacred Hearts House. The sisters run a pro-bono physical therapy clinic and diabetic eye clinic, retirement home for her elderly sisters as well as pro-life ministry including the Abortion Pill Reversal. Sister Dede's other service includes hands-on ministry in the rubble of the twin towers following the terrorist attack on 9-11, caring for the sick during the earthquake in Haiti in 2011 and annual medical missions to Haiti.

DR. JOSEPHINE LOMBARDI | Forgiveness and Healing

Dr. Lombardi has worked as parish minister, university campus minister, high school chaplaincy leader, educator through OECTA, professor of Religious Education, Brock University, retreat facilitator, faith formation consultant, coordinator in the Diocese of Hamilton. Presently, she is the Assistant Dean for Academic Affairs, the Associate Professor of Pastoral and Systematic Theology, Professor of Field Education, and Director of Lay Formation for St. Augustine's Seminary. She has done media work in radio and television and has been advisor to the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops in the area of doctrine and Catholic-Muslim relations. Her books *On Earth as it is in Heaven* and *Experts in Humanity* have been featured on Salt and Light TV. Dr. Lombardi is also the Series Theologian for the New Religious Education curriculum for Growing in Faith, Growing in Christ for Catholic School Boards.
