

Pearson FasyBridge Pearson eText for Schools

Introduction

Integrated Pearson content is available at your fingertips through your mobile device. Accessing your titles on your tablet – for both iOS and Android – is a download and click away. Using this guide, students will learn where to go to download the app and how to sign in using their integrated login – whether starting directly in the app or from the district portal.

This guide explains how students:

1. Download Pearson eText for Schools

Click on the link below to get started. You will have the option to download the free app for your specific device.

Note: Pearson eText for Schools is available through iTunes for the iPad and Google Play for Android tablets.

Once you have downloaded the app to your tablet, you are ready to login.

2. Sign In, Launch the App

a. Tap on the *Pearson eText for Schools* app.



After opening the *Pearson eText for* Schools app on your tablet, you will see the Sign In screen - similar to the login screen on the right.

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Tap the integration symbol directly below the **Sign In** button. This will take you to a landing page where you can locate and select your district. If you were instructed by your teacher to sign in directly, go to the **Sign In Directly to Your District Portal.**

b. Select your District and click Go


Type the name of your district in the search box and select it from the list that appears. Click **Go**.



c. Sign In Directly to Your District Portal

Depending on your integration, you will see a login screen for PowerSchool, District Portal or central login screen

Sign in using your integrated username and password. This will take you directly to the eText bookshelf in the app. The titles that appear on your bookshelf are determined by the courses your teachers have associated to classes.




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d. Sign in to eText for Schools App Directly

- i. Tap on the Pearson eText for Schools App.
- ii. Enter your credentials in the username and password fields.
- iii. Click the Sign In button.



- Note: Do not click on the orange bridge icon. Credentials do not work here when required to log in directly to the eText for Schools app.
- Note: If you encounter any issues logging in, try clearing your browser cache and then close the browser window. Try logging in again. If the problem persists, contact your teacher.
- 3. Begin accessing your titles in *Pearson eText for Schools* directly from your mobile device



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4. Sign Out

Sign Out of Mobile eText App

When you have completed your work in the mobile eText app and are ready to sign out, it is important to consider the following best practices. Select the scenario that is most applicable to your own situation.

Best Practice for Shared Devices: If you share a device with your classmates, it is best practice to always sign out of the mobile eText app when you have completed your work. This prevents others from accessing your classes and work.

Best Practice for One to One Device Use: If you are the only person using your device, it is best practice to remain signed in to the mobile eText app and do not power down the device. This allows you to work offline when you are not connected to the internet. Once you reconnect to the internet, your work will be available online.

Whether you are using a shared device, or have a dedicated device for your personal use, it is still necessary to sign out of any browser applications you have logged into. Signing out of either the app on the mobile device or any browser web application does not automatically sign you out of both.

Sign Out of EasyBridge and Learning Platforms

You only need to sign out of one application, including EasyBridge, (formerly Central Administrative Tool, CAT), Pearson SuccessNet, SuccessNet Plus, Pearson Realize, and Dash to sign out of all active sessions. When logged out of one application, you will be redirected to a page letting you know you have successfully signed out of all of your integrated Pearson learning platforms.
