Below details provides information about mostly used search options.

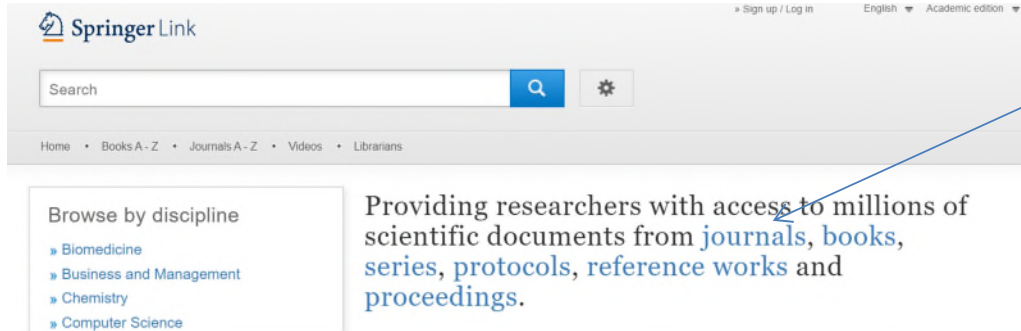

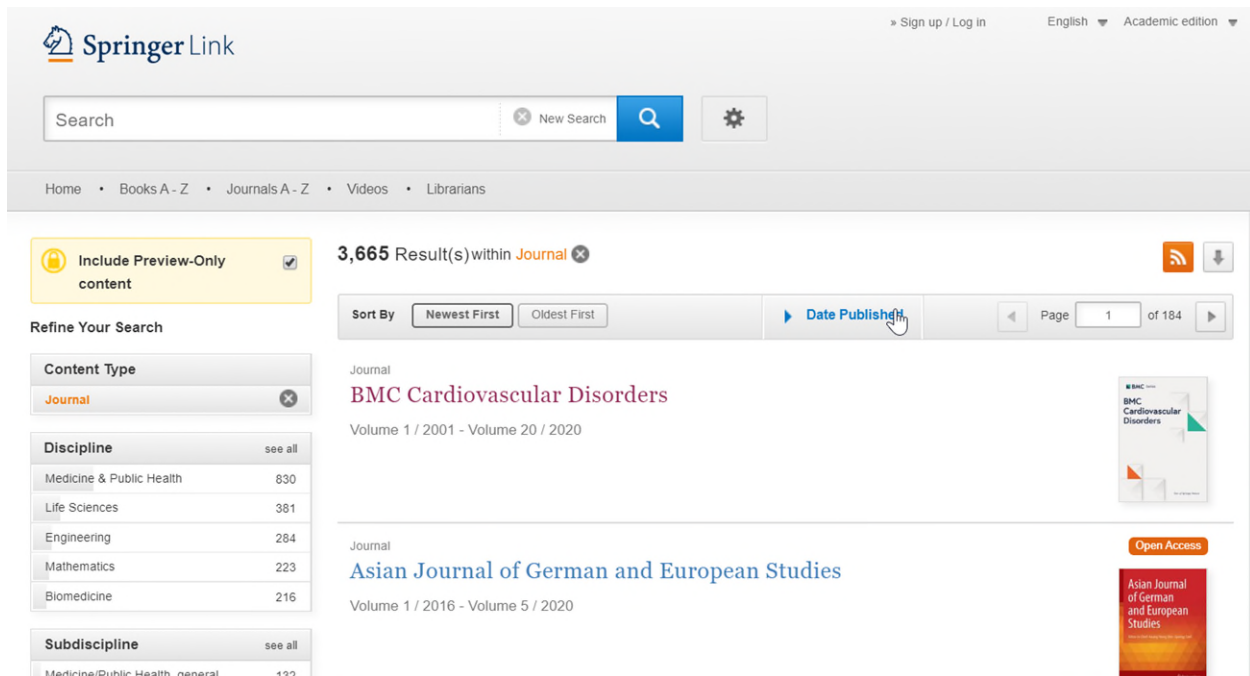




How to access all accessible content within your institutional IP using basic Key word search option
