

Microsoft Office 365 Government GCC Customer Validation Guide

User Guide

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To detail the various process steps to validate and configure an end customer for eligibility to participate in the Office 365 Government GCC for the CSP program.

No additional steps are required of Pax8 partners to qualify for the program and resell the GCC SKUs.


End Customer Requirements

End customers must each be individually validated by Microsoft for eligibility in the Government GCC for CSP program. This validation is only required if the customer has never been qualified before.

In order to determine if a customer is already qualified, check Partner Center to see if they have "Government Community Cloud" listed under their Account profile as seen in the screen shot below.

If they are qualified, then the customer is ready to have GCC SKUs provisioned under their tenant and no further setup or qualification is necessary.

If you do not see "Government Community Cloud" under Special Qualifications, they are not qualified, and you must validate them using the Customer Validation Process outlined below.



Customer Validation Process

To submit a new end customer for Government GCC for CSP eligibility, go to the Office 365 Government GCC for CSP validation page: https://products.office.com/en-us/government/eligibility-validation?ReqType=CSPcustomer and complete the form on behalf of the customer.



PLEASE NOTE: In the Partner Tenant ID field, you must use this ID number:


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It takes up to two business days for customer validation to be completed. During this time, Microsoft may contact the customer for additional information as part of the validation process. Once validation is completed the customer should receive a validation code from Microsoft. You will then use this code to purchase a GCC SKU for the customer in the Pax8 Portal. It can take an additional 24 hours after you receive the validation email for Pax8 to have the ability to create the tenant. You are welcome to try to use the code in the checkout process after receiving the email, but please be aware that it can take an additional 24 hours after you receive the email for us to have the ability to create the tenant. During the checkout process in the Pax8 portal, you will choose the desired GCC SKU, provide the desired domain, and input the validation code you received from Microsoft. After all steps are completed, you will then be sent credentials to log into the Microsoft portal for that customer.



Check Customer Validation Status

Step 1: In Partner Center select the customer and then select the "Account" option.



Step 2: If "Government Community Cloud" is displayed in the Special Qualifications section, the customer is validated for the Microsoft Cloud US Government.
