## Joint Deficiency Reporting System (JDRS)

In August 2006 the Joint Aeronautical Logistics Commanders (JALC) sponsored the Navy, Marine Corps, Army, Air Force, Coast Guard and Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA), to develop a Joint Deficiency Reporting System (JDRS) based on NAVAIR's NAMDRP application. JDRS provides a common, seamless solution for deficiency reporting and resolution management across the Aeronautical Enterprise.

JDRS is a cross-service web enabled automated tracking system designed to initiate, process and track deficiency reports from the <u>Warfighter</u> through the investigation process.
