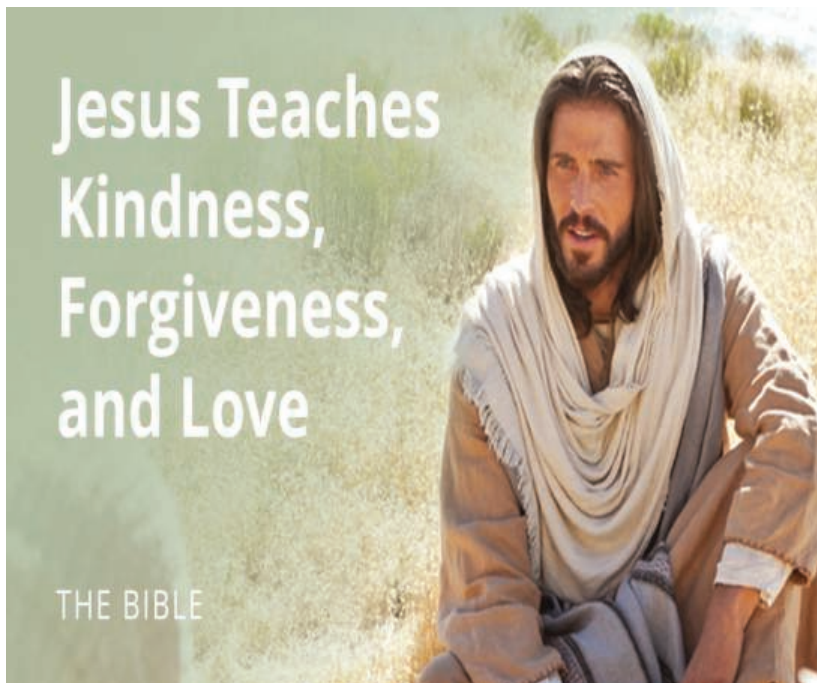

Scripture Reflection...

As we continue to bask in the light of the Resurrection, the Church asks us to reflect on the words Jesus spoke to his disciples the night before he died. In hindsight we now can understand what Jesus was saying to us. "Resurrection Faith" enlightens us in our understanding of Jesus' Farewell Discourse and furthers our personal transformation in the risen Christ.

Before embracing his death, Jesus issues commands that promise personal blessings. To fulfill these commands, we must first embrace our identity as living the freedom of the children of God. "I no longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing." Accordingly, we must not regard ourselves as enslaved by the urges of our passions, emotions, and longings. Rather we must accept the truth about ourselves in God's sight before we attempt to embrace his commands.

"Love one another as I have loved you." Jesus loves us as the Father loves us. That is to say, the Father loves Jesus as an equal, and Jesus in turn has loved us with that same equality. When we fail to acknowledge or believe in the reality of the way that Jesus loves us, we disable our own efforts to love one another as we ought.

However, when we open ourselves to experiencing and acknowledging Jesus' love for us, we in turn feel compelled to love. Love engenders love. In this, our joy is complete, because we are freed up to love God and neighbor completely. This is what we were created to do, and joy inevitably follows when we are one in loving as we are meant to love.

Jesus calls us to keep the commandments, even as he has kept the Father's Commandments. Doing the will of the Father unites us lovingly to Jesus. Jesus fulfills the Father's Commandments ultimately by laying down his life for his friends. Therefore, our friendship with Jesus requires that we too lay down our life, our will, our selfishness, our plans and ambitions out of love. After all, the commandments that Jesus gives us are themselves friends that lead us more deeply into intimacy with Jesus.

Stewardship Thought for the Week

"This is my commandment: love one another as I love you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." - John 15:12-13

Do you love Jesus? Do you consider Him your friend? Jesus says that if we love Him we would be willing to offer whatever we have to Him, not because we want praise and glory, but simply because we love Him. Does your giving seem mechanical out of obligation or do you share freely out of love?

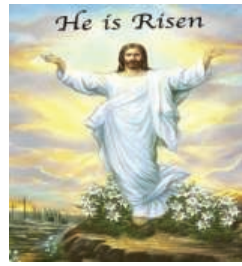

STV Food Pantry NEEDS your HELP!

The Parish food closet accepts donations of non-perishable foods on a weekly basis. The items collected are then delivered to our sister parish, St. Cyprian's in West Philadelphia, where approximately 300 families are assisted on a monthly basis.

Items most in need are: powdered milk, canned fruit and 100% fruit juice, peanut butter and jelly, tuna, canned chicken, cold cereal, oatmeal, pasta and pasta sauce, rice, stew, chili and soup, toilet paper and diapers.

Food may be dropped off Monday-Thursday, 9:00am to 4:30pm and on Fridays from 9:00am to 1:00pm. Please drop off at the Parish Center and on weekends to the back of the Rosemont Chapel (around Mass times when the Church is open.)

Please be mindful of expiration dates. We cannot deliver food items which are past their expiration dates. Thank you.

If you would rather not shop, please know that financial contributions are welcome and will allow parish volunteers to buy items for the parish food closet that directly benefit the food pantry at our sister parish, St. Cyprian.
