Extended forecast – Some wrap around showers will be possible Sunday morning as the upper-level low-pressure system moves off-shore. Cloudy, breezy and chilly conditions is expected for the afternoon with temperatures only reaching the upper 40s to around 50 degrees. The wind chill will make it feel like the mid to upper 30s during the morning hours and low to mid 40s for the afternoon. Clearing skies can be expected Sunday night with mostly sunny skies returning Monday.
