On the Tampa campus, our culturally diverse students hail from more than 140 countries around the world.



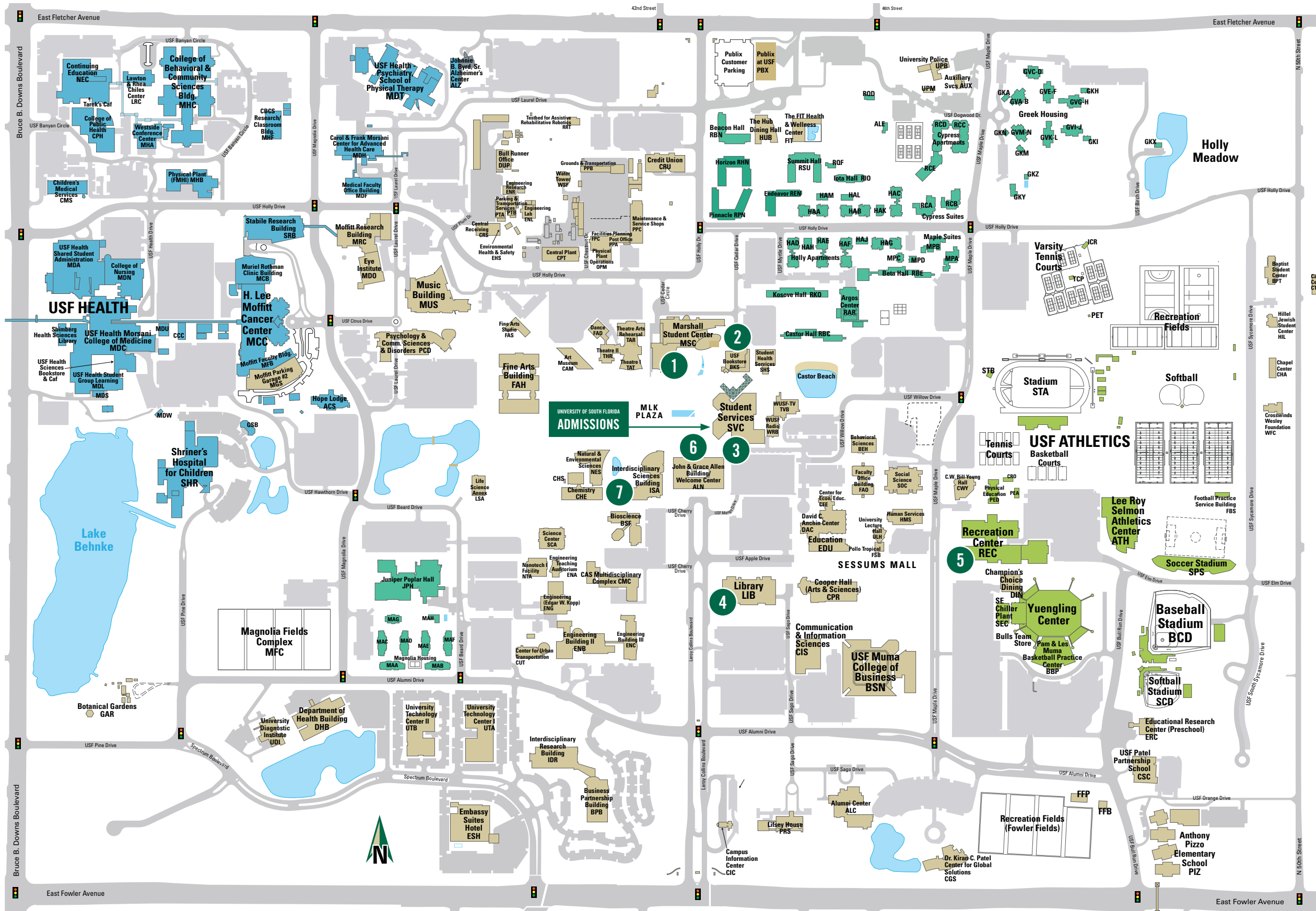
