

USF will not accept scores from the Common App portal, your guidance counselor, or PDF screenshot. Scores must come directly from SAT or ACT testing services.



Send original copies of academic transcripts, mark sheets, grade reports, diplomas or certificates, national standardized examination results or other academic coursework to USF. Transcripts not issued in English must be submitted along with a certified English translation.


