Find the Shapes

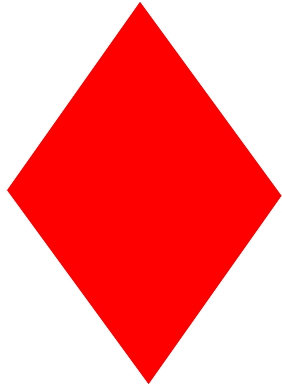
Trace the names of the shapes and then glue the cards to popsicle sticks. Read the book together and find the shapes in the book and also around your house.



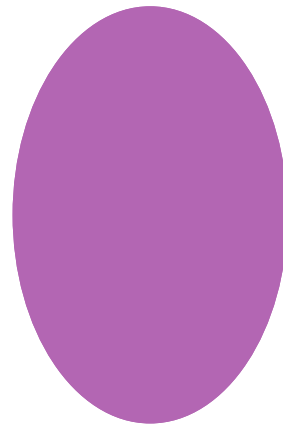




Print, laminate and cut out. Have your child either clip a clothespin to the correct number or use a dry erase marker to circle the correct number.

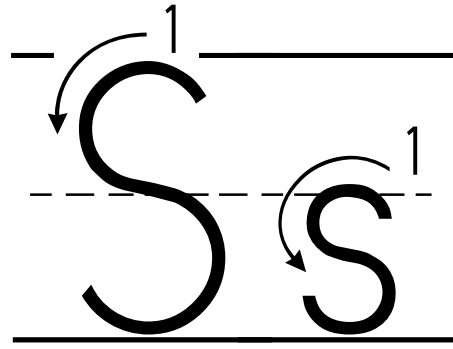
