Supply chain outlook

- Supply chain is seen as a **strategic asset**. The post-recession global marketplace recognizes supply chain management as a **key driver** of business success and viability
- Supply chain management is a well-established role in **industries beyond manufacturing**, including retail, health care and technology
- Supply chain and operations management jobs are **in demand**.
- **200,000** U.S. supply chain jobs will go unfilled annually until 2018 for lack of qualified talent*

Gartner's 2016 Chief Supply Chain Officer Survey

- Survey's goal was to understand the business priorities of Supply Chain
 - Supply Chain strategies and capabilities
 - Supply Chain organization and talent
 - Supply Chain of the future
- Top priority investments that provided the most value:
 - Quality of product supply: 50%
 - Sales and operations planning: 41%
 - Supply chain analytics: 42%
 - Product development and portfolio management: 41%

APICS Body of Knowledge

- The *APICS Operations Management Body of Knowledge (OMBOK) Framework* is the basis for global industry standards in supply chain and operations management.
- The *APICS Dictionary* establishes accepted terminology including more than 4,000 terms for inter-organizational communication.

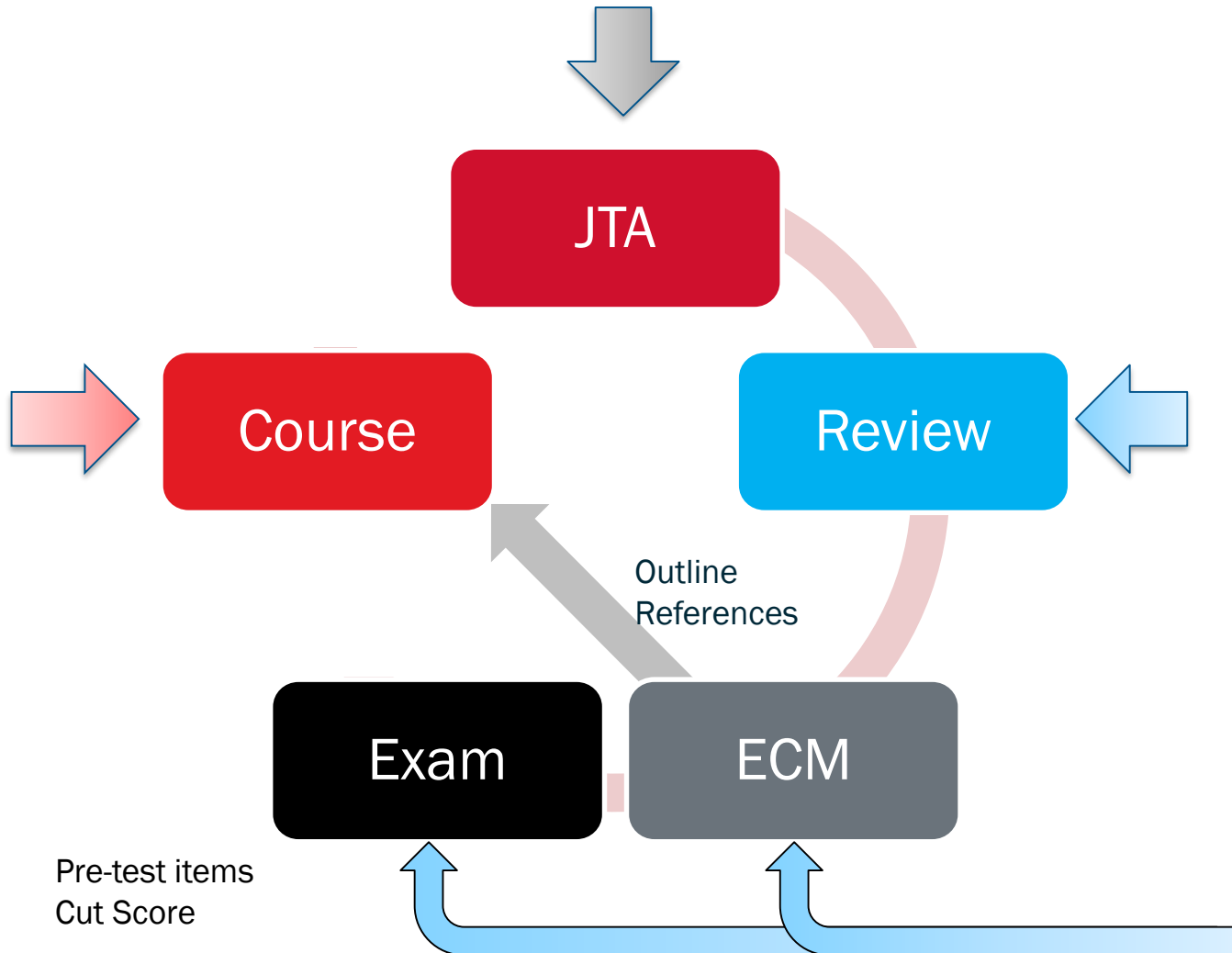

- Encompasses the planning hierarchy, including inventory management, to improve many of the processes within your company
- Consistent with principles used in the creation of ERP systems
- No prerequisites or eligibility requirements.
- 5 year certification maintenance period

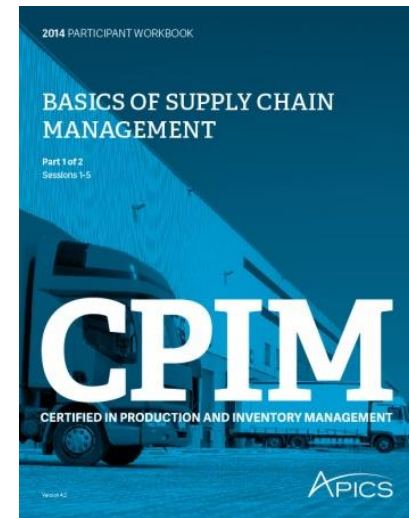

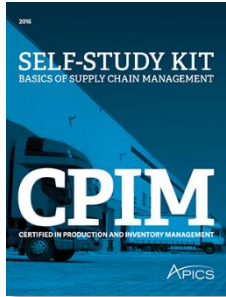

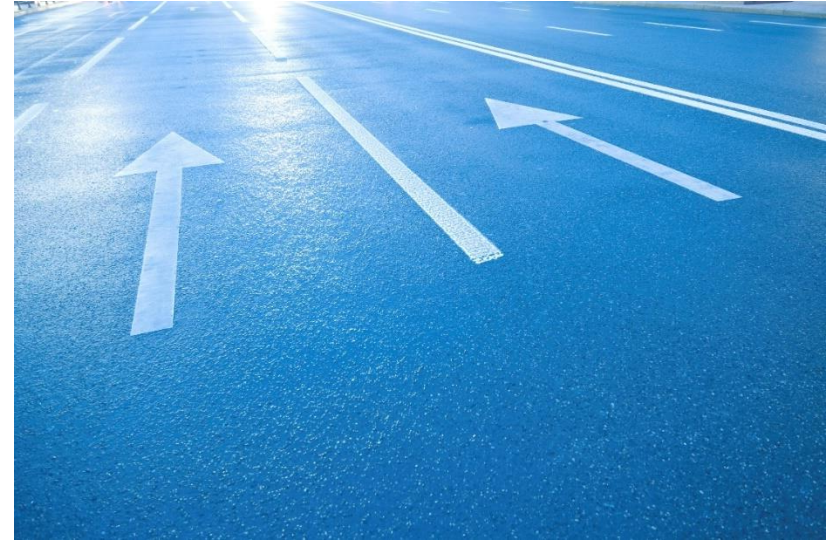

- Encompasses end-to-end supply chain—including suppliers and customers
- Breadth across many topics, including globalization, IT enablement, logistics, service industry and more
- Exam Content Manual (ECM) consists of three diagnostics; but there is only one exam
- Eligibility requirements: work experience & education
- 5 year certification maintenance period

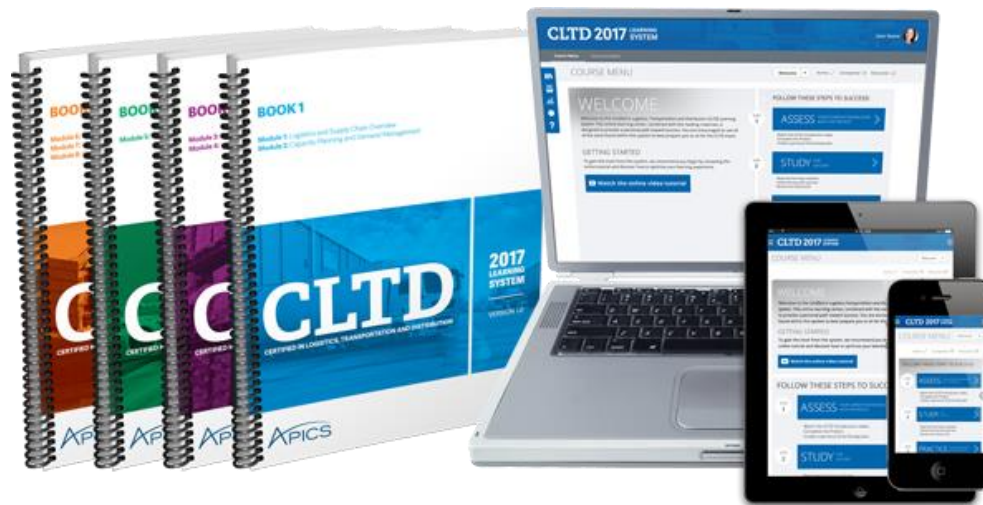
