Provider ALERT: Nursing Orders: Consider alternative diagnoses for cause of patient's [x] Place patient on continuous pulse ox if RASS -1 or Autonomic Hyperactivity or Mental Status Changes. lower [x] Elevate HOB if RASS -1 or lower (e.g. sepsis, hepatic encephalopathy) [x] Notify provider if RASS -2 or lower Lorazepam only recommended when age > 70, [x] Awaken patient to assess SEWS score **Overt Hepatic Failure (Jaundice, Ascites, Spider Angioma)**, [x] Do not administer Lorazepam if patient sedated End Stage Renal Failure or Pregnancy (RASS equal to -1 or lower) If SEWS Score 1 to 6 (MILD) [x] Reassess patient in 30 min if RASS -1 or lower [x] Lorazepam 2 mg PO Q4 hr PRN SEWS 1-6 [x] If 10 mg Lorazepam dose reached within 12 hrs, face-to-face provider assessment required before [x] Hold Lorazepam if RASS equal to -1 or lower continue protocol. [x] If 10 mg Lorazepam dose reached within 12 hrs, face-to-[x] If SEWS > or = 7 after three Lorazepam doses over 6 face provider assessment required before continue hours, call provider protocol.
