Deerfield Beach Middle school is ready to greet our students back on campus with safety measures in place for students and staff. We are also committed to providing options to parents for on campus or E- learning from home. **Please Note:** Only those students whose parent/guardian returned the online survey for campus learning will be allowed on campus and will interact directly, but safely with their teachers and classmates. On campus students **must** bring his/her laptop and power cord daily for E-learning will continue to be the primary method used for daily instructions. Students will be required to wear a face mask or personal protective equipment (PPE) in class, unless medical authorization states otherwise. Students will be seated in a socially distant layout in classrooms with all chairs, desks, and workstations six feet apart.

Only self-contained SVE classes (Ms. Baymon, Mr. Nixon, and Ms. Thomas classes) will return on Friday, October 9, 2020. Students in grade six will return on Tuesday, October 13, 2020. Students in grades seventh and eighth will return on Thursday, October 15, 2020.

This year we are utilizing an interactive online learning program called I Ready designed to assess students and provide individualized instruction based on each one's unique needs. The students take a math diagnostics test and the results of the assessment are used as a screening tool to measure student growth and identify students who may need support or follow up diagnostics.
