ENROLLED, An Act,
To provide for the reapportionment and redistricting Of the state into districts for the purpose of electing the members of the Alabama Senate until the release of the next federal census; and co repeal and reenact Section 29-1-2.3, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the Senate districts. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OE AIABAMA:

Section 1. Section 29-1-2.3, Code of Alabama 1975, reiating to the existing Senate districts, is repeaied.

Section 2. Section 29-1-2. 3 is added to the code of Alabama 1975, to read as Eollows:
§29-1-2. 3
(a) The Alabama Senate shall consist of 35 members. Each member eiected shall reside in the district which he or she represents or seeks co represent. The State of Alabama is divided into 35 Senate Districts as provided in subsection (b).
(b) The numbers and boundaries of the districes are designated and established by the map prepared by the Permanent Legislative Committee on Reapportionment and identified and labeled as Mcciendon Senate pian i, inciuding the corresponding boundary description provided by che census
tracts, blocks, and counties, and are incorporated by reference as part of this section.
(c) The Legislature shall post for viewing on its public website the map referenced in subsection (b), inciuding the corresponding boundary description provided by the census cracts, blocks, and counties, and any alcernative map, including the corresponding boundary description provided by the census tracts, blocks, and counties, introduced by any member of the Legislature during the legislative session in which this section is added or amended.
(d) Upon enactment of the act adding this section and adopting the map identified in subsection (b), the Secretary of the Senate shall cransmit the map and the corresponding boundary descripiion provided by the census cracis, blocks, and counties identified in subsection (b) For certification and posting on the public website of the Secretary ofi State.
(e) The boundary descriptions provided by the certified map referenced in subsection (b) shall prevaii over the boundary descriptions provided by the census traces, blocks, and counties generated for the map.

Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable.
If any part of this act is declared invaiid or unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the pari which remains.

Section A. This act shail become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
