Additional Information

- The SAT is an aptitude test created to determine college performance. The SAT includes two main sections: Math and Evidence Based Reading and Writing. Starting in 2021-2022 school year, the SAT Essay will no longer be offered. 400 – 1600 score scale. 3 hours - 4 answer choices. Cost of SAT \$55.
- The ACT is an achievement test based on information already learned by the student. The ACT tests math, critical reading, science, language arts, and writing (the writing test is optional, but recommended). Cost of ACT (No Writing) \$60 and ACT with writing \$80.
- When registering for the SAT and/or ACT, it is important to select up to 4 colleges to receive your scores directly. These are free when registering for the test; however, you will be charged an additional fee if you request your test scores to be sent to colleges after you have taken the test.
- Students receiving free and reduced lunch should see their counselor to receive a fee waiver form to register for the SAT and/or ACT tests.
