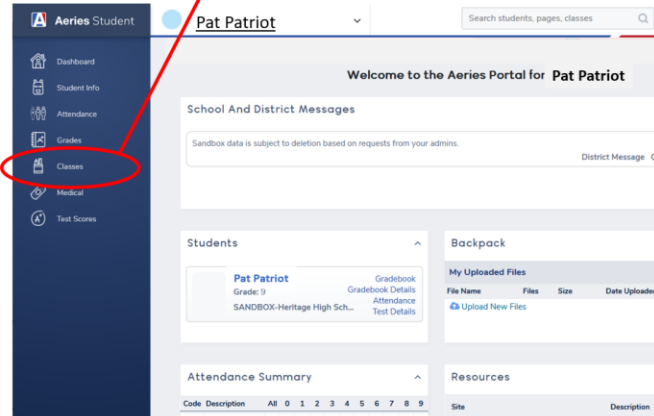

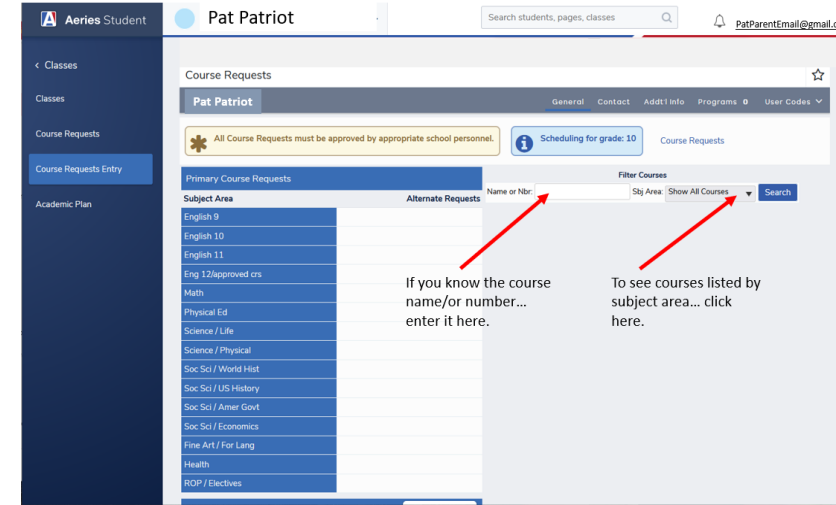
Online Course Request Instructions

1. Log in to your Aeries Portal (or have your parent log in.... Its all the same)
2. Click on the 'Classes' Menu



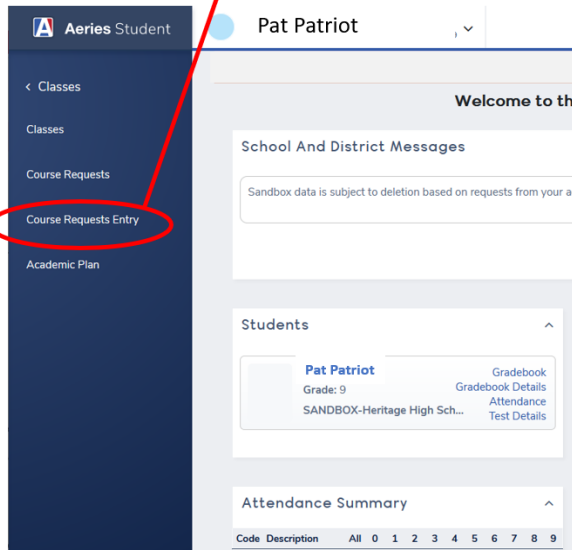
Step 1: Log into Aeries and click on Classes

On the Course Requests Entry page you will be able to enter all of the courses you want to take next year ... just as if you are writing them on your Course Request Form!

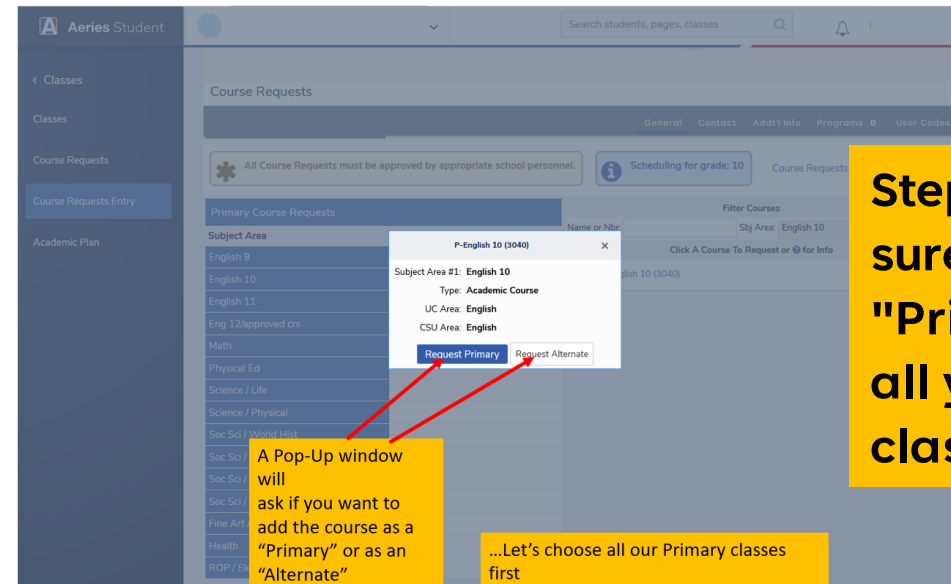


Step 3: Type in your classes in the search and select the course you want

Step 4: Make sure you select "Primary" for all your core classes

Online Course Request Instructions

Repeat that process for all of your Elective classes...

1. Select the subject area
2. Click on the class you want
3. Choose "Primary"

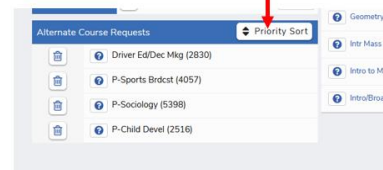
Step 5: Pick your first-choice electives and choose "Primary"

Requests will be scheduled in the order they appear here.

Do you want to change the order and move Sociology to the Top of the list??

No Problem! Just follow these steps:

1. Click on the "Priority Sort" button



2. The Trash Bins change to arrows and you can 'click and drag' the arrow next to Sociology to drag it to the top

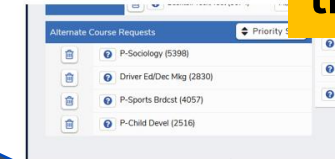


Step 7: Sort your alternates in the order you prefer these classes

Let's say you want Yoga as one of your "Alternate" requests.

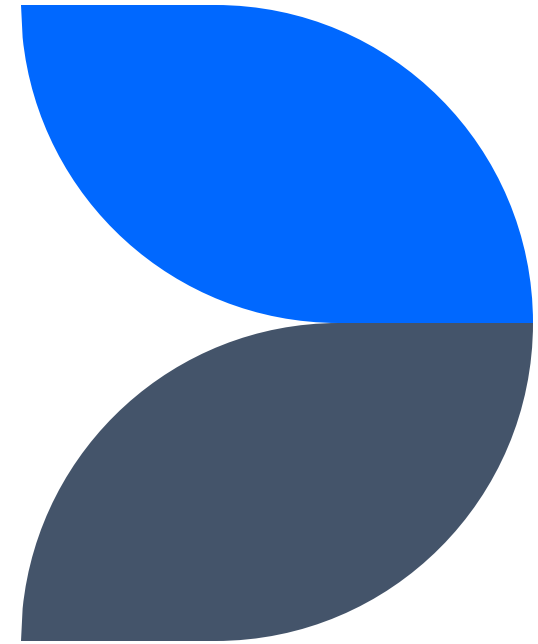
... Just click on the "Request Alternate" button when it pops up
