- one-time budgets, daily budgets, weekly budgets, bi-weekly budgets, monthly budgets, yearly budgets
- move remaining funds to the next budget
- learn from your budget history

### Bill organizer

- reminder for your bills as they become due
- plan family bills for upcoming months and know how much you can spend
- note when you need to repay your loans

How it can help students with autism: Involved but easy to use budget planner. Organizes ad helps set a budget. Can give reminder on when bills are due. Gives visuals of budget.
