Notes on Character Traits.

Character Traits

A character trait is the way a person or a character in a book acts (behavior). It's a part of their personality and it comes from inside. Because a character trait reflects who you are inside, it is very difficult to change these traits.

Some examples of character traits are:

selfish, childish, cooperative, bossy, lazy, brave, intelligent, dishonest, calm, active

Character Emotions

Emotions are usually fleeting feelings that may be due to an outside force. Emotions show through what a character says and does.

Some examples of character traits are:

happy, sad, quiet, nervous, excited, relieved, safe, hopeful, disappointed, shocked.
