How People Interact with the Environment

Humans have basic needs. We need water, food, clothing, and a place to live. When people are deciding where to live, they look for a place that has physical characteristics and natural resources that can provide food, clothing, and shelter.

We rely on resources in our environment to meet our needs. If you live on the beach, your environment includes the ocean, the fish, the trees, and the wind. People who live near the ocean often eat fish. They use the wind to power a sailboat. They use wood from trees to build homes to protect themselves from stormy weather. People usually choose to live close to resources that help them meet their basic needs.

People Adapt to the Environment

People adapt to their environment. This means people change how they live based on their environment. Trees and minerals are natural resources found in some environments. Forestry, mining, and drilling are examples of jobs created based on natural resources. 




Modifying the Environment
