
APPENDIX A

APPENDIX B

COMMON REGULATORY VIOLATIONS AND POSSIBLE PENALTIES

- 1. All state and federal statutes are enforced by the installation conservation officers, MPs, and state game wardens, and carry their own penalties.
- 2. In addition to any other penalty that applies, listed below is a compilation of common regulatory violations referenced within this regulation. Violations will carry a 30-day suspension of hunting privileges, unless otherwise noted.
 - a. Failure to properly display ODR card.
 - b. Hunting without prescribed hunter orange vest/jacket or headgear.
 - c. Traversing cross-country or through planted wildlife openings (food plots) with a motor vehicle.
 - d. Dismounting dogs to hunt prior to parking transporting vehicle.
 - e. Hunting with a dog without proof of a current rabies vaccination.
- f. Use of noise-producing devices (fireworks, blank pistols, indiscriminate shooting, etc.) to drive game.
 - g. Failure to have covered quiver for broad heads while bow hunting.
 - h. Parking a vehicle on Artillery Road while bow hunting.
 - i. Hunting or trapping within 200 yards of the ASP, airstrips, recreational areas, or buildings.
 - j. Use and/or possession on person of unauthorized ammunition.
- k. Use of ammunition other than .22-caliber or smaller rimfire firearm or shotgun (specified by state regulations) using number 6 or smaller size shot for hunting raccoon/opossum at night or .22-caliber or small rimfire ammunition to dispatch a trapped animal.
- 1. Bow hunting in an open gun area during firearm season without a vest and headgear of hunter orange.
 - m. Hunting in a gun area during gun deer season without a vest and headgear of hunter orange.
 - n. Hunting with firearms in bow only areas, such as training Area 19E.
 - o. Indiscriminate shooting or target practice while gun or bow hunting.
 - p. Shooting before or after the legal shooting hours specified in state regulations.
 - q. Training hunting dogs in an unauthorized area.

- r. Use of horses in conjunction with hunting.
- s. Riding of horses in an unauthorized riding area.
- t. Failure to register a weapon on Fort Rucker.
- u. Child in boat under eight (8) years of age not wearing a PFD.
- v. Improper safety equipment.
- w. Improper and/or expired watercraft registrations.
- x. Reckless and/or improper operation of watercraft.
- y. Riding of horses without vest or jacket (minimum of 144 square inches of solid hunter orange visible from any angle).
 - z. Unauthorized entry into any training area that is closed for training.
- 3. Following is a list of common violations and the maximum suspension of hunting or fishing privileges associated with the violations:






APPENDIX E LAKE THOLOCCO TRAFFIC PATTERN MAP




Area 1: All vessels must travel clockwise, keeping white buoys to the left and red buoys to the right. Vessels, jet skis, and wave runners pulling skiers or tubes must operate within the normal vessel/ski pattern.

- **Area 2**: Wave runners, paddle boards, jet skis, sailboats, canoes, and paddle boats must stay north of the red buoy line that runs from the West Beach boathouse to the East Beach pier, with the exception of wave runners or jet skis that are pulling skiers or tubes.
- Area 3: Fishing only. No PWC.
- Area 4: Large boat launching.
