#### **ACTIVITY NOTES**

- 1. Divide the class into two teams.
- 2. Have one student from each team come to the front of the class and randomly choose one card each.
- 3. The first student to write a grammatically correct sentence (using a comparative adjective) without spelling mistakes is awarded one point for their team.
- 4. The game continues as the remaining students take turns to come to the board.

#### **CONSIDER**

#### **CONSIDER** cont'd

Consider allowing only question sentences.

For example:

"Is Spain bigger than Thailane

"Is Spain bigger than Thailand?"

Consider leading into the activity by writing some examples on the board – noting the difference between singular noun comparisons and plural noun comparisons.

For example:

"Dogs <u>are</u> smarter than cats." vs

"The sun <u>is</u> bigger than the moon."

**Consider** NOT allowing any repeat use of adjectives. *For example:* 

"The sun is <u>hotter</u> than the moon."

and

"August is hotter than January."
