
## Logging in to the Microsoft Office 365 Portal at UMB


Office 365 (O365) for Education is a cloud-based collection of common suite of essential business applications. The core applications provided by Office 365 are:


- OneDrive for Business
- Skype for Business
- SharePoint Online
- Office Online
- Office 365 Pro Plus
- Exchange Online

### How do I log in to the Microsoft Office 365 Portal?

From any web browser, enter **portal.office.com**.







Collaborate with Office Online provides access to each of the Office 365 tools.

#### What Do These Tools Provide?

- OneDrive for Business Store your work files in a 'cloud-based' network space. You can update these files from anywhere you have access to the internet. You can also sync your files to a local (C:) hard drive and work offline too. OneDrive makes it easy to share files with other individuals if necessary.
- **Skype for Business** Web/video conference and instant message with colleagues. Skype for Business facilitates online collaboration and sharing of documents, your desktop, and programs.
- Office Online A collection of web-based versions of Word, Excel, PowerPoint and other applications for quick viewing and editing documents without the need for a locally installed, full versions of these Microsoft Office programs.
- Exchange Online The Outlook Web Access you know has received an upgrade! Now with 50 GB of storage while still allowing you to access your email from anywhere, with a web browser.
- Office 365 Pro Plus Is a subscription based version of Microsoft Office. Office 365 Pro Plus allows you to install Microsoft Office on up to 5 personal devices such as tablets, phones, home computers, etc.

Your office computers already has Microsoft Office, as provided by your school or department's IT administrators. Do not install Office 365 Pro Plus on your UMB office workstation.

#### What is Coming Soon?

• SharePoint Online – Team Sites for document sharing and collaboration. A very useful tool for long-term project teams, departments with shared documents and resources and other uses where a common document a resource repository is needed. This service is similar to Vibe here at UMB.
