SOUNDS BY THE NUMBERS Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and San Antonio Missions play game two of a four-game series tonight in San Antonio. The Missions handled the Sounds in game one last night, 11-1. Tonight, righthander Pedro Payano starts for Nashville against left-hander Drew Smyly for San Antonio.

> Pedro Payano: 24-year-old Pedro Payano starts for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 2-2 with a 3.08 ERA in 7 games (6 starts) for Nashville in 2019. Payano has pitched in Double-A, Triple-A and the big leagues this year. He last pitched on July 6 in what was his Major League debut. He tossed a scoreless inning against the Minnesota Twins at Target Field. Payano last worked for Nashville on July 4 in a 2.0-inning start against the Omaha Storm Chasers. He pitched in 8 games with Double-A Frisco and went 3-1 with a 4.43 ERA in 42.2 innings prior to being transferred to Nashville on May 29. Payano spent his 2018 season with Frisco where he went 5-10 with a 5.54 ERA in 25 games (22 starts). The New York City native is 43-36 in his minor league career with a 3.55 ERA while covering 138 games (121 starts). He was signed by the Texas Rangers as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2011.

> Drew Smyly: 30-year-old Drew Smyly starts for the Missions in tonight's game. The left-hander is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA in 2 starts for San Antonio in 2019. Smyly began the season with the Texas Rangers and went 1-5 with an 8.42 ERA in 13 games (9 starts) before he was designated for assignment on June 20. He was released five days later and signed to a minor league contract by the Milwaukee Brewers on July 1. Smyly last pitched on July 11 in a start against Omaha. He went 5.0 innings and earned the win after allowing 2 runs on 3 hits. He didn't walk a batter and struck out 3 in San Antonio's 9-2 win. The Arkansas native has pitched in the big leagues with Detroit (2012-14), Tampa Bay (2015-16) and Texas (2019). In 169 career games, he's 32-32 with a 4.13 ERA. The Detroit Tigers drafted him in the 2nd round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of the University of Arkansas.

Eli's Power Surge: Nashville shortstop/center fielder Eli White continued his power binge with another home run last night, his 12th of the season. White's previous season-high in home runs was 9 with Double-A Midland in 2018.

Eli's 15-12-10: White is one of only 9 players in the Pacific Coast League to have at least 15 doubles, 12 home runs and 10 stolen bases. He joins Round Rock's Kyle Tucker (20-24-21), Las Vegas' Jorge Mateo (20-13-18), Albuquerque's Sam Hilliard (20-26-17), Las Vegas' Franklin Barreto (24-12-13), Iowa's Trent Giambrone (17-19-13), El Paso's Michael Gettys (21-22-12), Tacoma's Kristopher Negron (15-12-11) and Reno's Abraham Almonte (23-12-10).

Davidson's Six-Gamer: Infielder Matt Davidson had his 19th multi-hit game of the season last night and is on a 6-game hitting streak. Since July 6, Davidson is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with 3 runs scored, 1 double, 1 home run and 3 RBI.

Roll A Pair: Nashville matched a season-high last night by turning three double plays. It's the second time the team has turned three in a game (April 30 vs. Omaha). The Sounds have turned 74 double plays in 2019 - the third-fewest in the Pacific Coast League.

The Arms Search Party: The Sounds are looking for pitching in the month of July with a team ERA of 6.90 (103.0 IP/79 ER) that is the 2nd-highest in the Pacific Coast League (Salt Lake - 8.74). Nashville's team ERA in the month of June was 4.92 as both the starters (4.95) and relievers (4.80) were sub 5.00. Starters in the month of July have a 6.07 ERA and the relievers are at 7.71.

Heineman's Heater: Since rejoining the Sounds on June 25, outfielder Scott Heineman has been on a tear. He is among Pacific Coast League leaders in batting average (2nd, .431), runs scored (T9th, 16), total bases (10th, 44) and walks (T8th, 12).

Nick Solak Arrives: Infielder Nick Solak has been assigned to Nashville after being traded from Tampa Bay in exchange for pitcher Pete Fairbanks. Solak is now rated the 10th-best prospect in Texas' organization and is the 9th-best second baseman overall by MLB Pipeline. He has played in 85 games with Triple-A Durham this season, hitting .266 (80-for-301) with 56 runs, 13 doubles, 1 triple, 17 home runs and 47 RBI. Solak was originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 2nd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Louisville.

Trevino Bouncing Back: Catcher Jose Trevino has hit well in his four games back since returning from his quad injury. After going 1-for-3 last night, he is 6-for-14 (.429) with a double, home run and 4 RBI. He currently rides a four-game hitting streak, a season-high. Trevino is currently ranked the 26th best prospect in the Texas Rangers organization by MLB Pipeline.

Last Outing: The last time Payano pitched was on July 6 in the big leagues. He made his Major League debut for Texas and tossed a shutout inning against the Minnesota Twins. He walked 1 batter and threw 11 pitches, 5 for strikes. His last outing for Nashville was on July 4 in a scheduled shortened start against Omaha. He went 2.0 scoreless innings in Nashville's 1-0 loss.

Against Opponent: Payano faced San Antonio five times in 2018 while playing for Double-A Frisco. He went 1-3 with 5.06 ERA (21.1 IP/12 ER) with 15 strikeouts and 15 walks.
