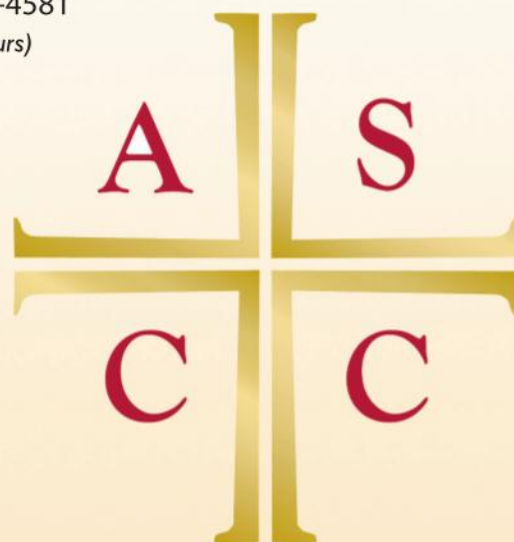

### From the Desk of Fr. Alfonso

#### Humbled and Exalted

Jesus said, "Whoever serves me must follow me." (Jn 12:24-26)  
"Whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me." (Lk 9:48)  
"Whoever loses his life for me will find it." (Mt 16:25)  
"Whoever wants to be first must be slave to all." (Mk 10:44)  
"Whoever does the will of my Father is my brother, my sister..." (Mt 12:50)  
"Whoever drinks the water I will give will never thirst" (Jn 4:14)  
"Whoever has will be given more." (Mt 13:12)  
"Whoever wishes to come after me must pick up his cross and follow." (Mk 8:34)  
"Whoever humbles himself will be exalted." (Mt 23:12)

**Invitation.** We could do a meditation for weeks on just these gospel passages. Truly, the Good News of Jesus Christ is that he is

constantly inviting me, personally, to a life of holiness. Every morning we should wake up and ask the Lord, "How may I serve you?" My way of life – my outlook on life - will be radically different from this day forward. To be humble means to make myself available to serve the Lord. My life will take on new meaning for I am here because the Lord needs me. The day I die will mean the Lord no longer needs me!

**Conditions.** Along with the invitation come certain conditions. Of course! How else would we know when the King expects us or how we should dress? "Whoever" wishes to follow Jesus must follow his example. When in Rome, do as the Romans do. Otherwise, "Whoever exalts himself will be humbled." The Lord, who gave more, loved more and forgave more than anyone else did not "taste and see" the good life; but he

did live the best Life, the greatest life, the truest life!

**Acceptance.** "Jesus spoke to the crowds and to his disciples, 'the scribes and the Pharisees have taken their seat on the chair of Moses. Do and observe all things whatsoever they tell you, but do not follow their example. For they preach but they do not practice.'" St. Francis would tell his missionaries, "Preach the Gospel always, if necessary use words." This holds true for all those in positions of authority – fathers and mothers included. We have been created in the image and likeness of God, not the other way around. Our fatherhood and motherhood are created in the image of God's eternal Fatherhood and Motherhood. Acceptance of God's Will reveals man's glory, and "the glory of the Lord will dwell in our Land" (Ps. 85:10b).

**Illegal Parking  
Arapaho Rd., Meadowcreek Dr. & Fire Lanes  
Cars WILL Be Towed**

We realize, parking for Sunday Mass can be challenging sometimes, especially if you arrive close to the start time of Mass, or you are running late. If you find the parking lots at All Saints are full, you can find a parking space across Meadowcreek Drive, at the shopping center.

- Parking your car on Arapaho Road is illegal and dangerous. Arapaho is a very busy street, **with no parking allowed**. THIS IS THE LAW. Last weekend the Dallas Police Department wanted to tow the cars parked on Arapaho. Our staff intervened asking for time to reiterate this law to our parishioners. We were given a reprieve, but we were warned that towing will begin this weekend – October 7/8.
- We have also been notified by the Dallas Police Department that cars are illegally parked on Meadowcreek Drive during Mass times at All Saints. The police department provided us this information as a courtesy to forewarn our parishioners to heed the posted signs regarding where you may park and where it is illegal to park.
- This is also the case for illegal parking on the All Saints parking lots. **Fire lanes are clearly marked**. These are no parking zones, established for emergency vehicles only. Please don't jeopardize the safety of our parishioners by parking in emergency zones.
- Complaints continue to be reported to our All Saints pastoral office by residents of the Meadow Crest Apartments (apartments on Meadowcreek Dr. across the street from All Saints). The Meadow Crest parking lot has clear signage that parking in the apartment parking lot is for their residents only. The residents have indicated they will request cars be towed, if they are illegally parked.
- Parking Lot on Meadowcreek Dr. - There is one main entrance to the Meadowcreek Dr. parking lot (center) which is clearly marked by our beautiful, new monument sign indicating we are "All Saints Catholic Community". We have two exits from the parking lot (north and south end of lot on Meadowcreek) back on to Meadowcreek. **PLEASE** pay attention to the **ENTRANCE** and **EXIT** signs and follow traffic accordingly. We've had numerous close call accidents, because people enter thru the exits and exit thru the entrance. Adhering to the signs, will help keep you safe, and help our parking lot traffic move safely.

**Above all, we ask you to be patient and courteous to our fellow parishioners and guests, as you enter and exit our parking lots.**
