APPLICATION FEE WAIVER

The application processing fee may be waived for Suffolk County residents who are veterans, auxiliary police, members in good standing of a local fire district or ambulance company, volunteer CERT members, members of the Suffolk County Police Explorers program and members of a Volunteer Fire Department or Volunteer Emergency Medical Services Agency Explorers program. The fee may also be waived if you are unemployed and primarily responsible for the support of a household and for recipients of Medicaid, SSI, Public Assistance or those in a training program under the Job Training Partnership Act/Workforce Investment Act administered by a state or local social service agency. All claims for application fee waiver are subject to verification. If you can verify eligibility for application fee waiver, complete a "Request for Application Fee Waiver and Certification" form and submit it with your application. SUBSTITUTE SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS

If you are looking to make a difference in the community, we may have a job for you!

The Suffolk County Police Department is actively hiring school crossing guards. This is an important part of the police department as these individuals are responsible to the safety of children, controlling traffic in school zones and escorting pedestrians across busy intersections in the mornings and afternoons.

Eligible candidates can apply through their local precinct. Unless requested, crossing guards are assigned to an intersection within the precinct they live in. The starting pay is currently \$20.00/hr. Both permanent and substitute positions are available.

Permanent positions offer part-time hours during school arrival and dismissal (17.5hrs/wk), while receiving the same medical, vision and dental benefits as full-time Suffolk County employees (combined is worth over \$20,000 in benefits). All crossing guards will have a flexible schedule.

<u>SUPPORT SERVICES SUPERVISOR PR</u> REQUIRES: To be eligible, a candidate must now be serving and have served on a continuous basis with permanent or contingent permanent competitive status as a <u>Mailroom Supervisor or Print Shop Supervisor</u> in the jurisdiction in which the candidate seeks promotion for at least <u>two (2) years</u> immediately preceding the written examination date.

<u>YOUTH SERVICES COORDINATOR OC</u> REQUIRES: Graduation from a college with federally-authorized accreditation or registration by NY State with a Bachelor's Degree* and six (6) years of experience in adolescent social work or a related youth field, two (2) years of which must have been at an administrative level.

Note: Additional relevant education* from a college with federally-authorized accreditation or registration by New York State will be substituted for non-supervisory experience on a year-for-year basis up to a maximum of two (2) years.

<u>ASSISTANT COUNTY ARCHITECT PR</u> REQUIRES: To be eligible, a candidate must now be serving and have served on a continuous basis with permanent or contingent permanent competitive status as an <u>Architect</u> for at least <u>two (2) years</u> in the jurisdiction in which the candidate seeks promotion immediately preceding the written examination date.

Candidates must possess a professional architect's license issued by New York State at the time of appointment, and maintain said license throughout employment in this title.

ASSISTANT FACILITIES SPACE MANAGER OC REQUIRES Graduation from a college with federally authorized accreditation or registration by NY State with a Bachelor's Degree*, and three (3) years of experience in real estate analysis, building space analysis, and/or building operation and maintenance.

Note: Additional experience may be substituted for education on a year-for-year basis up to a maximum of two (2) years.

FACILITIES SPACE MANAGER OC REQUIRES: Either: (a) Graduation from a college with federally authorized accreditation or registration by New York State with a Bachelor's Degree*, and six (6) years of experience in real estate analysis or building space analysis; at least four (4) years of this experience must have been in an administrative capacity; or, (b) Graduation from a college with federally authorized accreditation or registration by New York State with a Bachelor's Degree*, and six (6) years of experience in building operation and maintenance; at least four (4) years of this experience must have been in an administrative capacity.

Note: Additional education* beyond the Bachelor's Degree may be substituted for non-administrative experience on a year-for-year basis; or, Additional experience may be substituted for education on a year-for-year basis up to a maximum of four (4) years.

*Please attach to the application a copy of your college transcript(s) which must have your name, college name, and date of graduation printed on it by the institution. Grade reports, incomplete transcripts and other similar documents are <u>unacceptable</u>.

<u>FIREFIGHTER / FIREFIGHTER-EMT</u> REQUIRES: Graduation from a standard senior high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and status as an active paid or volunteer firefighter, or as a retired paid firefighter. Necessary Special Requirements

At the time of appointment and during employment in the Firefighter/EMT title, employees must possess a valid Emergency Medical Technician certificate issued by the New York State Department of Health. The type of certificate required will be determined and specified by the appointing authority during the hiring process based on the level of care to be provided.

In agencies employing five (5) or fewer paid firefighters, any additional education, health and physical fitness qualifications shall be determined by the appointing authority as per Section 58-a (6) of the New York State Civil Service Law.

In agencies employing six (6) or more paid firefighters, additional Minimum Standards for Firefighting Personnel as per NYCRR Part 426, include completion of a qualifying Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) and completion of a certified basic training program within 18 months of appointment. There will also be a qualifying medical exam as per NFPA 1582.

At the time of appointment in this title, employees must possess a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in New York State.

Throughout employment in this title, employees may be required by the employing agency to pass an annual physical evaluation including drug testing.

DEPUTY SHERIFF I OC REQUIRES: Graduation from a standard senior high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma recognized by the New York State Department of Education by the date of appointment.

Special Age Requirement: Candidates must be at least 19 years and 6 months old on or before the date of the written test. Pursuant to Section 54 of Civil Service Law, applicants within six months of the minimum age will be permitted into the competition. Therefore, candidates who will be 19 years of age by the exam date will be eligible. Eligibility for appointment as a Deputy Sheriff I begins when the candidate reaches age 20. Candidates who reach their 35th birthday before the date of the written exam are not eligible except as follows: Candidates may have a period of active military duty, up to seven years as defined in Section 243 (10-a) of the Military Law, deducted from their age for purposes of determining whether they meet the age requirement.

License Requirement: Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at the time of appointment.

<u>Residence Requirement</u>: There are no residence requirements to compete in this examination. However, pursuant to local law, **only Suffolk County residents are eligible for appointment**. To be deemed a resident of Suffolk County, an applicant must have been a legal resident of Suffolk County at the time of certification for appointment and for at least 90 calendar days prior thereto.

<u>Police Officer Training Course Requirement</u>: After appointment, candidates will be required to successfully complete a Police Officer Training Course recognized by the New York State Municipal Training Council.

<u>Citizenship Requirement</u>: Candidates must be United States citizens at the time of appointment.

<u>Note</u>: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 217A of the County Law, candidates who have been convicted of a felony will be barred from appointment and candidates who have been convicted of a misdemeanor may be barred from employment.

WRITTEN TEST DATE: APRIL 2, 2022

LABOR SPECIALIST II PR REQUIRES: To be eligible, a candidate must now be serving and have served on a continuous basis with permanent or contingent permanent competitive status as a <u>Labor Specialist I</u> for at least <u>one (1) year</u> in the jurisdiction in which the candidate seeks promotion immediately preceding the written examination date.

Necessary Special Requirement

At the time of appointment and during employment in this title, candidates must possess a valid New York State driver's license.

<u>PUBLIC HEALTH EDUCATOR OC</u> REQUIRES: Either: (a) Graduation from a college with federally-authorized accreditation or registration by NY State with a Bachelor's Degree* in Public Health, Health Education, Health Science, Health Promotion, Community Health, or Health Communications; or, (b) Graduation from a college with federally-authorized accreditation or registration by NY State with a Bachelor's Degree* in Education, Nursing, Epidemiology, Wellness and Fitness, or Nutrition, and one (1) year of experience in health education. <u>Necessary Special Requirements</u>

Candidates will be required to satisfactorily complete 15 hours of continuing education in health education related topics approved by the New York State Health Department within one year of appointment.

At the time of appointment and throughout employment in this title, employees are required to possess a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in New York State.

*Please attach to the application a copy of your college transcript(s) which must have your name, college name, and date of graduation printed on it by the institution. Grade reports, incomplete transcripts and other similar documents are <u>unacceptable</u>.

<u>PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE III PR</u> REQUIRES: To be eligible, a candidate must now be serving and have served on a continuous basis with permanent or contingent permanent competitive status as a <u>Public Health Nurse Coordinator for at least two (2) years</u> or as a <u>Public Health Nurse II or Clinical Nurse Practitioner for at least one (1) year</u> in the jurisdiction in which the candidate seeks promotion immediately preceding the written examination date.

Necessary Special Requirements

At the time of appointment and during employment in this title, candidates must possess a Professional Registered Nurse's License issued by the New York State Education Department.

Candidate must complete 15 hours of continuing education in public health and management related topics approved by the New York State Department of Health within the first year of employment.

At the time of appointment and during employment in this title, candidates will be required to possess a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in NYS.

Candidates must meet federal and NYS employee health requirements, including but not limited to immunizations, for programs to which they are assigned.

Necessary Special Requirement

<u>VOLUNTEER PROGRAM COORDINATOR OC</u> REQUIRES: Graduation from a college with federally-authorized accreditation or registration by NY State with a Bachelor's Degree*, and two (2) years of experience in the administration, supervision or coordination of social or community services in a public or private agency.

*Please attach to the application a copy of your college transcript(s) which must have your name, college name, and date of graduation printed on it by the institution. Grade reports, incomplete transcripts and other similar documents are <u>unacceptable</u>.

CONTINUOUS RECRUITMENT

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN (BASIC) OC REQUIRES: Possession of one of the following certificates issued by the New York State Department of Health: Emergency Medical Technician-Basic Certificate; Emergency Medical Technician-Intermediate Certificate; Emergency Medical Technician-Critical Care Certificate; or Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic Certificate. Please attach to the application a copy of your currently valid certificate.

Note: Separate eligible lists will be established for each title.

Necessary Special Requirements (Vary by jurisdiction)

- 1. Candidates must maintain the appropriate Emergency Medical Technician Certificate throughout employment in this position.
- 2. Candidates may be required to possess the appropriate New York State driver's license, and maintain such license throughout employment in this position.
- 3. Candidates must be free of any speech or hearing defects that would impair functioning in this position.
- 4. In jurisdictions where required, the incumbent must obtain certification of completion of the appropriate National Incident Management System (NIMS) entry-level course(s), including Incident Command System (ICS) training, within 26 weeks of appointment.
