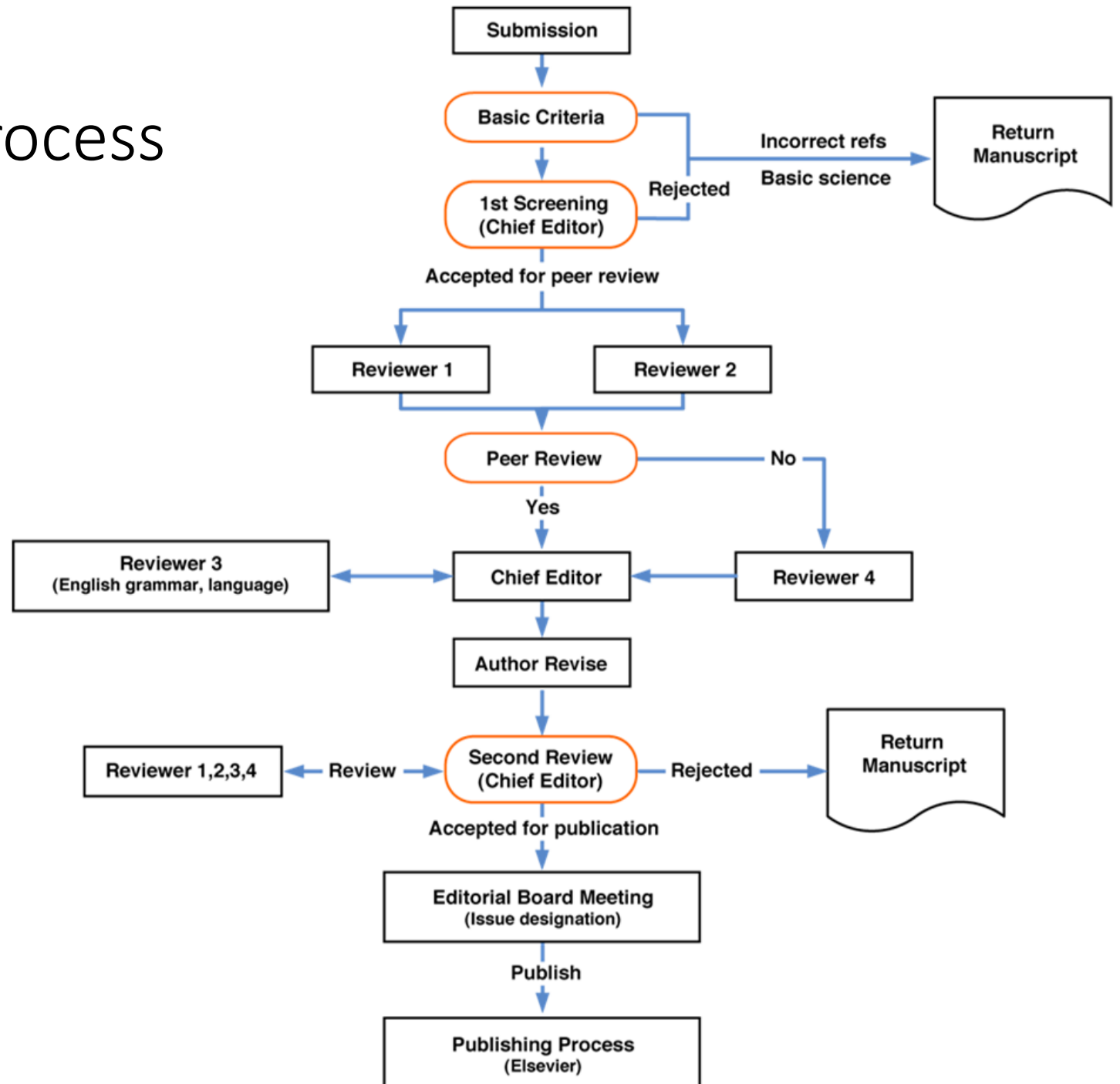
Nature of Scientific Communication

- Early scientists shared their observations and results in **open letters** to their colleagues that were hand copied and passed from person to person.
- One of the most common ways for scientists to formally share their research is to publish a “**journal article.**”

PEER REVIEW

- Scientific **peer review** is the **evaluation of work by** one or more people of similar competence to the producers of the work (**peers**). It constitutes a form of self-regulation by qualified members of a profession within the relevant field.
- **Peer-reviewed** journal articles have been **evaluated** by several researchers or subject specialist in the academic community **prior to accepting it for publication**. Also known as scholarly or refereed.
- The **peer review** process is integral to scholarly research. It is a process of subjecting research methods and findings to the scrutiny of others who are experts in the same field.
