



## MySECO Feature:

**How do I access tools exclusive to eligible military spouses?**

The Department of Defense Self-Service Logon is a secure, self-service logon ID that allows DoD and Veteran Affairs affiliates to access several websites using a single username and password. The DS Logon is the same process you use to access other online services like TRICARE, for example.

## How does it work?



MySECO uses the Department of Defense Self-Service Logon service to access tools offered exclusively to military spouses.

You must be enrolled in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System, or DEERS, to create your Department of Defense Self-Service Logon, or DS Logon account.

If you are an existing DS Logon user, enter your username and password and then click 'Log in' to proceed.

If you don't have a DS Logon account, you'll need to create one to access MySECO. Click 'Register' to get started.

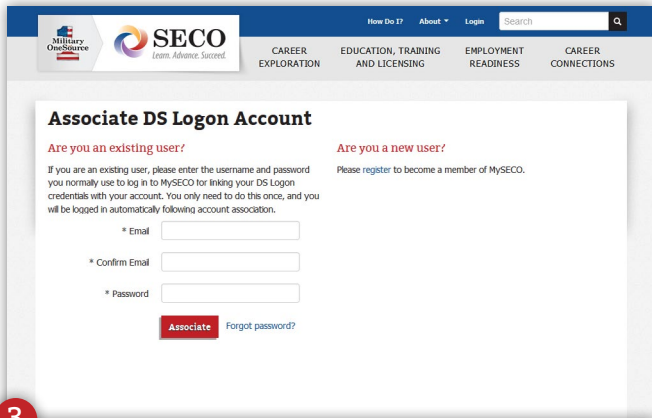

Once you're authenticated using DS Logon, you'll be returned to MySECO.

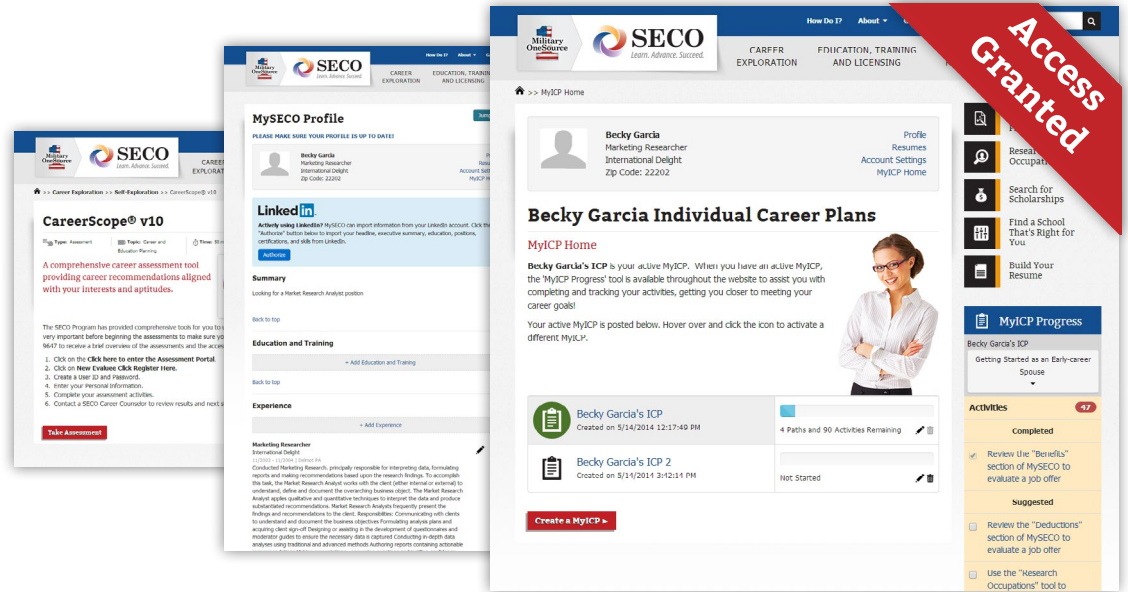
Associate your MySECO account with your DS Logon account in one of the following ways.

1. For existing MySECO users, enter the email address and password you used previously to access your MySECO profile. Then, click 'Associate' to link your accounts.
2. If you are new to MySECO, click 'Register' to begin the MySECO registration process.



**Check it out!**

You only need to associate your MySECO account with your DS Logon one time.
