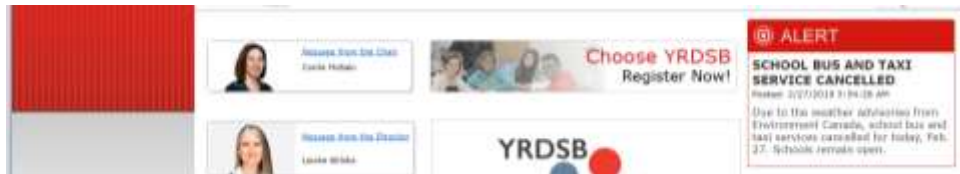

### A Message to Families About Possible Exposure to Pediculosis (Head LICE)

**We were informed that several students have lice – they cover all divisions so we are sending this letter to everyone.**

Your child may have come into contact with a student who has pediculosis (head lice). Head lice are common in school-aged children. They are not considered to be a communicable disease and they do not cause illness, however they are a nuisance and can spread easily. Anyone can get them.

**We encourage you to check your child's head. If your child has nits (eggs) and/or live lice, we request that you notify the school and apply treatment as soon as possible.** Your child can continue to attend school when they are free of live pediculosis and when treatment has begun.
