In Sidama, baby names are given based on:

- 1. An event that happens when the baby is born. eg. Jilo: A baby born during feast. Fichcho: A baby/girl born during fichee celebration.
- 2. A month or day in which a baby is born. eg. Ammajje: A baby born in February. Dikkaashe: A girl born on a day of Dikko.
- 3. A time that a baby is born. eg. Beeddakko: A girl born during night hours. Agana: A baby born during a full moon time.
- 4. A wish of parents. eg. Ararso: A baby who arbitrate a dispute between parties. Dureette: a rich, baby girl.
- 5. Past events: eg. Riqiwa: a baby born after loss of a child.
- 6. Character or nature of a child. eg. Amalao: A baby that makes trouble. Fayo: a beautiful girl. Danbowa: a tiny baby.
- 7. Association with things that are loved. eg. Sunkurta: an aromatic fragrant smelling garden plant. Furra: legendary sidama woman.
