1 January	New Year's Day
28 January	Australia Day
19 April	Good Friday
22 April	Easter Monday
25 April	ANZAC Day
25 December	Christmas Day
26 December	Boxing Day

All banks are closed on National public holidays and, accordingly, no payments are processed.

Furthermore, National public holidays are also classified as non-business days in terms of AUD / Foreign currency trades and therefore are not good value dates upon which to settle Australian dollar foreign exchange transactions.

#### **NEW SOUTH WALES**

Date	Holiday
10 June	Queen's Birthday holiday (All States and Territories except Western Australia and Queensland)
5 August	Bank Holiday (NSW Only)
1 October	Labour Day (NSW Only)

In addition, the three NSW public holidays listed above are also classified as non-business days in terms of AUD/ foreign currency trades. However, in contrast to National public holidays, payments will still be able to be processed.
