
### Overview of TRS: History & Mission

  - Actuarial target returns of 7.25 % per annum




### Overview of TRS: TRS Investment Diversification Framework

The Trust is allocated across the following groups:









### **Emerging Manager Program**

#### **Emerging Manager Definition**

TRS typically defines emerging managers as those with:

- Assets Under Management
  - > Firms that manage less than \$3 billion
- Target Fund Size
  - > Preference for Funds less than \$1 billion
- Generation
  - > Fourth generation or earlier institutional funds

#### **Manager Criteria**

The EM Program targets managers with, but not limited to, the following attributes:

- Attributable track record within target strategy
- Investment teams with history of working together
- Principals known in the investment community and are positively referenceable
- Availability of co-investment opportunities
- Strategic alignment of interests

#### **Asset Classes**

The EM Program currently targets the following asset classes:

- Private Equity
- Real Estate
- Energy, Natural Resources, and Infrastructure
- Hedge Funds
- Long Only

#### **Private Markets Investment Focus**

- The EM program includes the following types of investments:
  - Fund commitments
  - Co-investments
  - > Fundless sponsors
  - Joint ventures
  - Seeding arrangements
  - Secondaries
- Primarily U.S. based investment strategies

### **Premier List Process**

- Private Markets reviews the Premier List semi-annually
  - Criteria to be considered for the Premier List:
    - Best-in-class manager in terms of performance, partnership quality, openness and transparency
    - Each Premier List manager is analyzed on several categories, subcategories and on additional quantitative and qualitative criteria
    - Manager composition is appropriately aligned to achieve longterm allocation targets by strategy and geography
- TRS may remove a GP from the Premier List for any reason, including the following:
  - Poor performance
  - Bad behavior or bad acts
  - Portfolio change by TRS or strategy change by the GP
  - Succession issues

### Private Markets: TRS' Legal Non-Negotiable Items

TRS will not commit to any investment fund which does not adhere to the following legal items:

- <u>Conflicts Regarding TRS Persons</u>: GP must represent and disclose certain conflicts with TRS Persons including with respect to personal or private relationships or interests in the Fund.
- <u>Sovereign Immunity/Indemnification</u>: TRS maintains all the protections of a State of Texas sovereign entity (cannot waive any rights of protections of the State) and maintains its immunity from suit and unlimited liability (except for the obligation to contribute capital). TRS cannot directly indemnify any other party.
- Restricted Securities: TRS is restricted from directly holding certain securities and must report direct and indirect holdings of such securities.
- <u>Ex parte Communications</u>; Political Contributions: GP must make certain representations regarding it or the Fund's lobbying activities or political contribution to Texas elected officials.
- <u>Placement Agent; Placement Fees; Improper Influence Policy</u>: GP must complete the questionnaire and comply with the Policy and the remedies that occur if the GP or its Placement Agent violates the Policy.
- <u>Benefits and Bribery</u>: TRS must comply with state law requirements that prohibits TRS persons from receiving certain benefits or gifts. TRS must also comply with Texas anti-bribery statutes.
- <u>Public Information Act</u>: TRS must comply with state law requirements and its process for addressing public information requests.
