

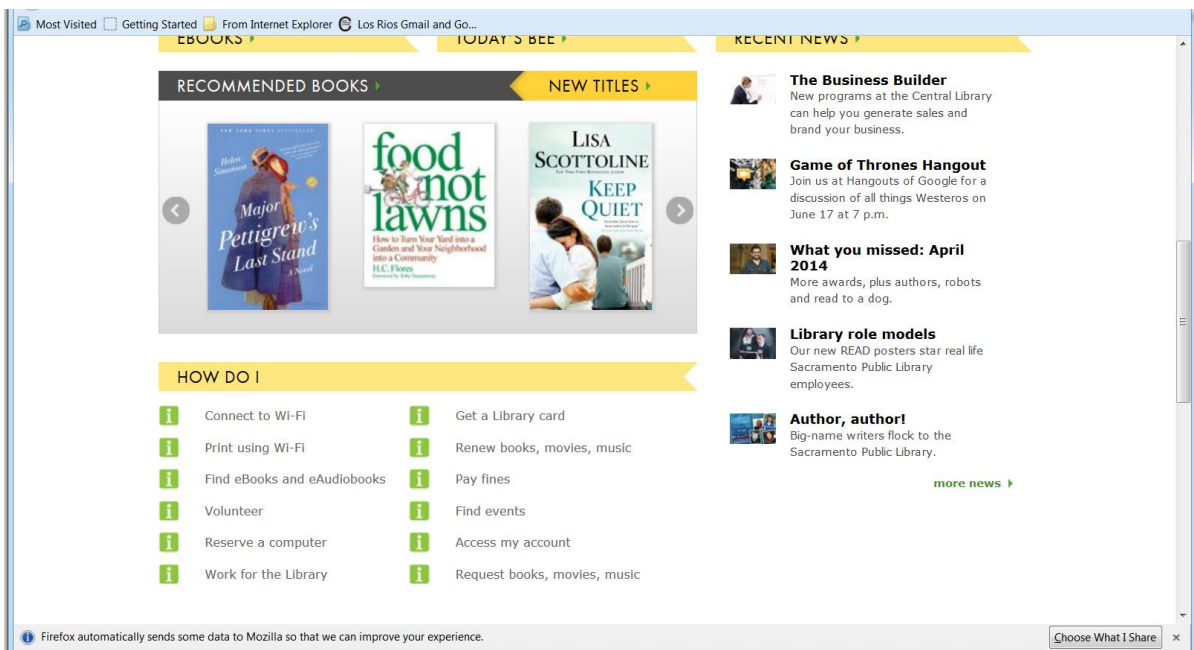
# Online Live Tutoring Assistance

The Sacramento Public Library has partnered with American River College (ARC) and the Learning Resource Center and its Tutorial Center to give you free access to resources that can assist you in your academic success.

Online live tutoring is available Sunday--Saturday 1pm-11pm for homework help in the following college level subjects: Algebra, Biology, Calculus 1, Chemistry, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, Statistics, and Trigonometry. 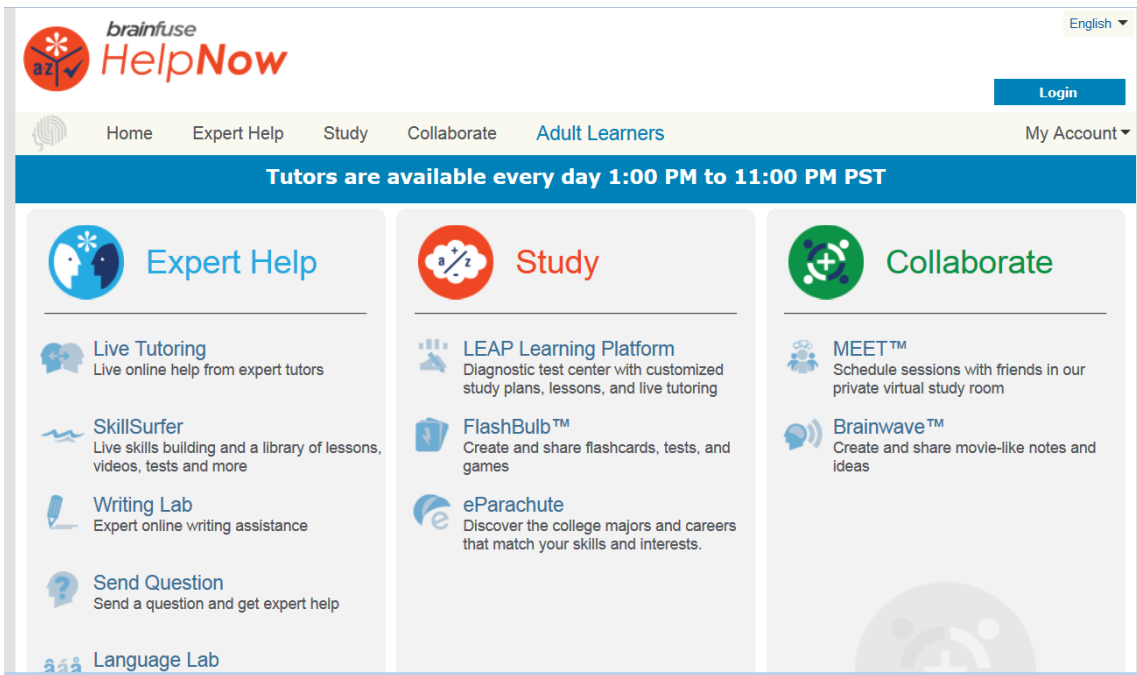

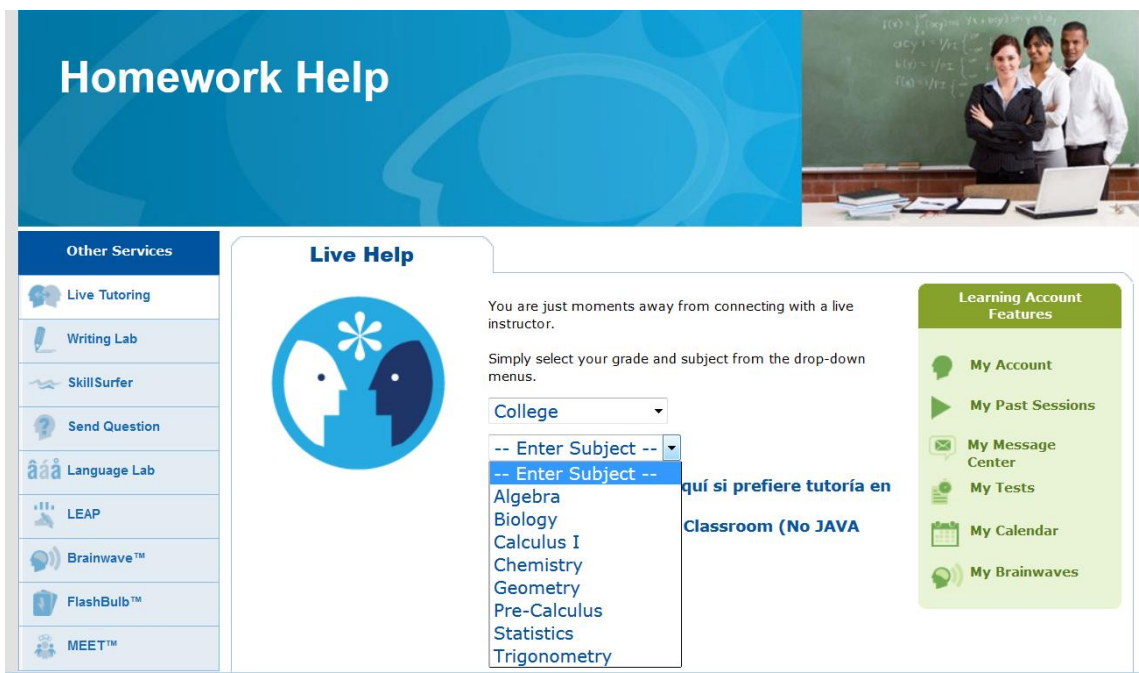
