Illinois State Police – State Trooper Application Instructions

Thank you for your interest in the Illinois State Police Merit Board. Please read this document carefully. Pay close attention to the instructions and minimum requirements. Please contact IOS Recruitment at recruitment@iosolutions.com with any questions.

Minimum Requirements:

- \$30.00 non-refundable application fee
- U.S. Citizen
- Valid Driver's License
- Twenty-one (21) years of age at time of application. *The Illinois State Police requires mandatory retirement at 60 years of age*
- No Felony Convictions
- Must be willing to accept assignment anywhere in the State of Illinois

Must meet one of the following options:

- Bachelor's degree
- Associate of Arts or Science Degree, Associates of Applied Science in Law Enforcement/Criminal Justice Degree or Sixty (60) semester hours from a regionally accredited institution **PLUS** three (3) consecutive years of continuous, full time service as a police officer with the same police agency
- Three (3) consecutive years of active military duty with an honorable discharge
- Any person who has been awarded a Southwest Asia Service Medal, Kosovo Campaign Medal, Korean Defense Service Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, or Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal
- Served in a combat mission by proof of hostile fire pay or imminent danger pay with an honorable discharge

NOTE: Sixty (60) semester hours must meet all of the following criteria:

- 9 semester hours in Communications studies
- 9 semester hours in Social Science studies
- 6 semester hours in Natural Science studies
- 3 semester hours in Math studies
- 9 semester hours in Humanities studies
- 24 semester hours in other electives

* The college or university must be accredited by one of the following associations:

- Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools
- North Central Association of Colleges and Schools
- New England Association of Schools and Colleges
- Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges
- Southern Association of Colleges and Schools
- Western Association of Schools and Colleges



ILLINOIS STATE TROOPER APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Visit iosolutions.com to complete the online application for the position of State Trooper. You will receive a confirmation number when your online application is complete; save this number for your records.
- 2) Return original, signed release forms and other required documents (see checklist) to IOS Recruitment (Attn.: ISP Trooper, Kensington Rd., Ste. 110, Oak Brook, IL 60523) as soon as possible. The earlier we receive your required documentation the sooner you will be considered eligible to sit for the written exam. Faxed or postmarked release forms will NOT be accepted. Documents may be delivered by hand (during business hours) or by mail; traceable courier is suggested to ensure timely delivery.
- 3) **ORIGINAL, OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS** submitted in **SEALED** envelope indicating completion of education requirements **MUST** be submitted to IOS Recruitment, ATTN: ISP Trooper, 1520 Kensington Rd., Ste. 110, Oak Brook, IL 60523. Education requirements **MUST** be met **before the application is completed**.
Note: if you attended a college/university or its equivalent outside of the United States, you MUST have your transcript evaluated. Contact IOS Recruitment with questions.
- 4) Once you are deemed an acceptable applicant, you will be given instructions (via email) as to the next steps in the process.

Candidates who submit applications lacking proper documentation as indicated on the checklist will be deemed unacceptable. I/O Solutions, d.b.a. IOS Recruitment, is not responsible for late, misdirected or incomplete application submissions. You must submit all required documents and have successfully CONFIRMED your online application in order to be deemed an acceptable applicant. You may drop your application documents off in person or by mail. IOS Recruitment will NOT confirm receipt of documentation; it is highly suggested that required documents are sent via traceable carrier (i.e. UPS, FedEx, etc.).

Applicants will receive notification from the Illinois State Police Merit Board (through a self-identified email address) regarding time and exact location for testing.

All portions of the testing process are mandatory. Failure to attend and successfully complete any portion of the process will result in elimination from the current application process.

**FOUR-ITEM FITNESS TEST
FOR ILLINOIS STATE POLICE OFFICER APPLICANTS**

Practical exercise performance requirements are fitness activities related to law enforcement tasks. The following practical exercise performance requirements have been identified and must be satisfactorily performed for successful completion of the Merit Board’s Fitness requirement.

As with any new physical regimen, please consult your physician before beginning.

1. **SIT AND REACH TEST** - This is a measure of the flexibility of the lower back and upper leg area. It is an important area for performing police tasks involving range of motion and is important in minimizing lower back problems. **The score is the distance, in inches, reached on a yardstick.**

2. **ONE MINUTE SIT-UP TEST** - This is a measure of the muscular endurance of the abdominal muscles. It is an important area for performing police tasks that may involve the use of force. It is also important for maintaining good posture and minimizing lower back problems. **The score is the number of correct sit-ups completed in one minute.**

3. **ONE REPETITION MAXIMUM BENCH PRESS** - This is a maximum weight pushed from the bench press position, measuring the amount of upper body force that can be generated. It is an important area for performing police tasks requiring upper body strength. The test will be conducted on a Universal DVR-Chest Press. **The score is a ratio of weight pushed divided by body weight.**

4. **1.5 MILE RUN** - This is a timed run to measure the heart and vascular systems’ capability to transport oxygen. It is an important area for performing police tasks involving stamina and endurance and to minimize the risk of cardiovascular problems. **The score is in minutes and seconds.**

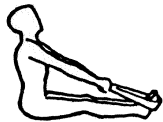
HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE FITNESS TEST

1. Preparing for the sit and reach test.

Perform sitting types of stretching exercises daily to increase this area.



Sit And Reach. Sit on the floor with legs straight. Slowly bend forward at the waist and extend fingertips toward the toes (keep legs straight). Hold for 10 seconds. Repeat 5 times.



Towel Stretch. Sit on the floor with legs straight. Wrap a towel around feet, holding each end of the towel with one hand. Lean forward and pull gently on the towel, extending the torso toward toes. Hold for 10 seconds. Repeat 5 times.

2. Preparing for the sit-up test.

Do as many bent leg sit-ups (hands behind the head) as possible in one minute. This is the set number.

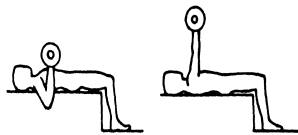


Do 3 sets at a time, at least 3 times a week.

3. Preparing for the one repetition maximum bench press.

If weights are available, determine the maximum weight that can be bench pressed at one time.

Calculate 60% of that weight to determine training weight. A set is 8 – 10 repetitions of that weight.



Do 3 sets weekly, adding 2 ½ to 5 pounds every week.

If weights are not available, push-up exercises can be utilized. Determine how many push-ups can be done in one minute. This is the set number.



Do 3 sets at a time, at least 3 times a week.

4. Preparing for the 1.5 mile run.

Below is a gradual schedule that will enable a maximum effort for the 1.5 mile run. If possible, advance the schedule on a weekly basis, proceeding to the next level. If the distance can be covered in less time, that should be encouraged.



Week	Activity	Distance	Time	Frequency
1	Walk	1 mile	20 minutes – 17 minutes	5 times weekly
2	Walk	1.5 miles	29 minutes – 25 minutes	5 times weekly
3	Walk	2 miles	35 minutes – 32 minutes	5 times weekly
4	Walk	2 miles	30 minutes – 28 minutes	5 times weekly
5	Walk/Jog	2 miles	27 minutes	5 times weekly
6	Walk/Jog	2 miles	26 minutes	5 times weekly
7	Walk/Jog	2 miles	25 minutes	5 times weekly
8	Walk/Jog	2 miles	24 minutes	4 times weekly
9	Jog	2 miles	23 minutes	4 times weekly
10	Jog	2 miles	22 minutes	4 times weekly
11	Jog	2 miles	21 minutes	4 times weekly
12	Jog	2 miles	20 minutes	4 times weekly
