#### **Program Services**

Offers free stroke risk assessment to adults 18 years and older twice a year in Boyle County and the surrounding counties. The screening is followed up with counseling by an RN who explains the significance of the laboratory work, helps the client set a reasonable lifestyle goal, and develop a plan for decreasing one's risk for having a stroke. Tests include free blood glucose, lipid panel, stroke score, blood pressure, BMI, height, weight, and pulse. Referrals may be made.

#### **Program Services**

Heart of Kentucky United Way is striving to not only help individuals who are hurting, but also to tackle the root causes of community issues so that more people can avoid crisis. Heart of Kentucky United Way partners with community programs serving Boyle, Garrard, Lincoln and Mercer counties by impacting our schools, workplace and neighborhoods in the areas of Education, Income, and Health.

#### **Program Services**

Provides care and support to enhance the quality of life in the final stages of living. Hospice care is for the patient whose illness is no longer responding to aggressive curative treatment.
