CAVS QUICK FACTS

- After last night's 109-100 win over Utah, the Cleveland Cavaliers hit the road for a two-game road trip, beginning tonight in the nation's capital. This is the second of four regular season meetings between the Cavaliers and Washington Wizards this season. Since the 2012-13 season, the Cavs are 13-6 against the Wizards, which includes an 8-2 mark on the road.
- Cleveland has won three straight games at Capital One Arena, which includes a 130-122 win on Nov. 3. In the win over the Wizards, the Cavs scored a season-high 130 points on 46-82 (.561) shooting from the field, 12-27 (.444) from beyond the arc and 26-28 (.929) from the foul line. Defensively, the Cavs had 11 steals and gave up zero fast break points. Over the last three meetings in Washington D.C., the Cavs are averaging 125.0 points on .504 shooting from the field, including .459 (45-98) from three-point range.
- Since Nov. 11, the Cavs hold the best record in the NBA at 17-1 (.944), including 7-1 on the road. Over that 18-game stretch, the Cavs have outscored their opponents by an average of 9.1 points (111.9-102.8), while also averaging 25.4 assists.
- CAREER MARKS & NBA HISTORY: LeBron James (10,746 FGM) is 4 field goals away from passing Hakeem Olajuwon (10,749 FGM) for the 9th-most field goals made in NBA history. James (1,526 3FGM) also needs 3 triples to pass Nick Van Exel (1,528 3FGM) for 24th place on the NBA's all-time three-point field goals made list. Channing Frye (993 3FGM) is 7 three-pointers away from 1,000 for his career. Kyle Korver (2,126 3FGM) is 18 threes shy of passing Paul Pierce (2,143 3FGM) for the 4th-most three-pointers made in league history.
- Cleveland has dished out at least 30 assists in each of the last three games. The last time the Cavs had 30+ assists in three or more consecutive games was from March 8-16, 1993 (4 straight), (Elias Sports Bureau)
- The Cavs have made at least 10 three-pointers in a franchise-record 19 straight contests and scored at least 100 points in 23 consecutive games (2nd-longest in team history).
- In last night's win, Tyronn Lue garnered his 100th win as head coach of the Cavaliers, becoming the fastest coach in team history to reach that mark (153 games). Lue joins Lenny Wilkens (316), Mike Brown (305), Bill Fitch (304) & Mike Fratello (248) to reach 100 wins as a Cavs head coach.
- For the second game in a row and for third time in four games, LeBron James registered a triple-double (5th this season, 60th of career) after tallying 29 points (9-15 FG). 11 rebounds and 10 assists in 37 minutes. With his triple-double, James passed Larry Bird (59) for the 6th-most tripledoubles in NBA history. Last season, James recorded back-to-back triple doubles on three occasions (Jan. 23-25, March 9-11, April 2-4). The last time he had a triple-double in three straight games was in March 2009 (3/7/09-3/12/09).
- In the Nov. 3rd win at Capital One Arena, LeBron James tallied a franchise-record tying 57 points (23-34 FG, 2-4 3FG, 9-9 FT), 11 rebounds, seven assists, three steals and two blocks in 43 minutes. James set a career-high and franchise record in field goals made (prev. 20 by three different Cavs players) and scored the 29,000th-point of his career with his dunk at the 7:31 mark of the first quarter, becoming the 7th player to reach that plateau and the youngest (32 years, 308 days). In addition to his 11th career 50-point night (tied for 6th-most in NBA history), James set the Capital One Arena record for points and extended his double figure scoring streak to 800 regular season games.
- Kyle Korver has scored in double figures in 4 straight games and leads all NBA bench players in plus/minus (+217) and is tied for 1st in threepointers made (77). Korver also leads the entire league in triples made in the fourth quarter (37).
- Over the last 9 games (since Nov. 30), Jeff Green is averaging 12.0 points (.541 FG%, .429 3FG%), a perfect 22-22 mark from the foul line, and 4.3 rebounds in 23.8 minutes.

KEY PERFORMERS: Kevin Love notched his team-leading 8th double-double of the season with a team-high 32 point on 9-14 (.643) shooting, a season-high 16 rebounds, three assists, two steals and one block in 35 minutes; It was the second time that Love has recorded at least 30 points and 15 rebounds as a Cavalier (12/29/16 vs. BOS, 30 pts. 15 reb.)...LeBron James recorded 30 points on 10-20 (.500) shooting from the field, a team-high nine assists, eight rebounds and a game-high tying three steals in 37 minutes of action...J.R. KING OF THE COURT

LeBron James is off to a strong start this season, averaging a team-high 28.1 points (3rd in NBA) on a career-best .579 shooting from the field (6th in NBA), 8.4 rebounds (21st in NBA), a team-high 9.1 assists (3rd in NBA), 1.43 steals (22rd in NBA) and 1.10 blocks (26th in NBA) in 37.2 minutes per game. He has 21 double-doubles (3rd in NBA) and 5 triple-doubles (2nd in NBA). James is also shooting a career-high .407 from three-point range this season. He is the only NBA player with averages of at least 25.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 8.0 assists in 2017-18.

- 205 & 305: He has scored at least 20 points 26 times and 30 points or more 12 times this season. He has also shot at least .500 from the field in 26 of 30 games in 2017-18.
- THE CLOSER: LeBron James has the highest scoring average in the NBA in the fourth quarter (9.1) and also leads all players in the final period in total points (247), field goals made (91) and assists (63). In the Nov. 22nd win over Brooklyn, he scored 23 of his 33 points in the fourth quarter, including a stretch of 18 consecutive points for Cleveland (most consecutive points James has scored in a fourth quarter in any regular season). He was also just two points shy of his best scoring quarter of his career (25 in 3Q vs. CHA on 3/3/14). (Elias Sports Bureau)
- .550 FG% & .400 3FG%: LeBron James (2012-13, .565 FG%, .406 3FG%) and Chris Mullin (1996-97, .553 FG%, .411 3FG%) are the only two NBA players ever to finish a season shooting at least .550 from the field and .400 from threepoint range (minimum 75 3-pt FGA). James is on track to repeat the feat this season. (STATS, Inc.)
- **DOUBLE-DIGIT STREAK:** LeBron James' double figure scoring streak is currently at **821 consecutive regular season** games, the second-longest in NBA history (Michael Jordan-866)
- 400TH 30-POINT GAME: LeBron James posted his 400th career regular season 30-point game on Nov. 1, 2017 against Indiana (33 PTS), becoming just the 6th player in NBA history to have 400 30-point games.
- 3RD BEST SHOOTING GAME: In a win over Atlanta on Dec. 12, 2017, James tallied 25 points on 11-13 (.846) shooting, a career-high tying 17 assists and seven rebounds in 35 minutes. His .846 field goal percentage was the thirdhighest of his career. His two highest games are .929 (13-14) on 2/4/13 vs. CHA and .875 (7-8) on 1/27/16 vs. PHX. Also against Atlanta, James became the 2nd player in NBA history to compile at least 25 points and 17 assists in a game with a field goal percentage of 84 percent or better, joining Oscar Robertson (Dec. 15, 1968, 26 PTS, 17 AST, .889 FG%).
- 57-POINT NIGHT IN WASHINGTON, D.C.: LeBron James had a huge night at Washington on Nov. 3, 2017, posting his second-highest scoring game of his career with 57 points on 23-34 (.676) shooting, a perfect 9-9 mark from the foul line, a game-high 11 rebounds, a team-high seven assists, three steals and two blocks in 43 minutes. Check out what else James accomplished that night:
 - SET FRANCHISE RECORD for points by a Cavs player in regulation (57, previously 56 by James on 3/20/05 at TOR)
 - TIED FRANCHISE RECORD for points in any game (57, also by Kyrie Irving on 3/12/15 OT at SAS)
 - SET FRANCHISE RECORD AND CAREER HIGH in field goals made (23, previously was 20 by three diff. Cavs players)
 - TIED FRANCHISE RECORD for field goals made in a half (14 in the 2nd half, also by Mike Mitchell on 2/8/80 at HOU)
 - Scored the 29,000th point of his career with his dunk at the 7:31 mark of the first quarter, becoming the 7th player to reach that plateau and youngest (32 years, 308 days).
 - Passed Kevin Garnett (10,505 FGM) and John Havlicek (10,513 FGM) for 11th all-time in field goals made and passed Shawn Marion (1,759 STL) for 18th in career steals.
 - Became the oldest player (32 years, 308 days) in NBA history to register at least 55 points, 10 rebounds and five assists in a game, a mark that was previously held by Wilt Chamberlain, who had 58 points, 25 rebounds and six assists at 30 years, 176 days old in 1967. (Elias Sports Bureau)
 - It was James' 11th career 50-point game and his most since March 3, 2014 vs. Charlotte (61 PTS). He tied Allen Iverson (11) for the 6th-most 50-point games in NBA history (Wilt Chamberlain-118, Michael Jordan-31, Kobe Bryant-25, Elgin Baylor-17, Rick Barry-14).
 - Set a Capital One Arena record for points in a game by any player. He also has arena scoring records at Air Canada Centre (56), AmericanAirlines Arena (61) and Vivint Smart Home Arena (51 -- tied with Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf and Karl Malone). (ESPN Stats & Info)
- 29.000 AND NEARING 30,000 PTS: With his dunk at the 7:31 mark of the first quarter at Washington on Nov. 3, 2017, LeBron James became the 7th player in league history to reach the 29,000point mark, as well as the youngest to do so at 32 years and 308 days, passing Kobe Bryant (did it at age 33 years, 199 days). He is now closing in on 30,000 points.
- TOP 25 ALL-TIME IN POINTS & ASSISTS: LeBron James is currently the ONLY player in NBA history to rank in the Top 10 in points and Top 15 in assists. James moved all the way up to 7th alltime in scoring and 12th all-time in assists in 2016-17. (See chart on right)
- BEST OF THE MONTH: LeBron James was named the Kia NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Month for games played in October/November 2017. It was James' 35th player of the month honor the most in NBA history (next closest is Kobe Bryant-17 times). James appeared in all 22 contests in October and November and averaged 28.0 points (.583 FG%, .425 3FG%), 8.2 rebounds, 8.5 assists, 1.32 steals and 1.18 blocks in 37.0 minutes.
- WEEKLY DOMINANCE: LeBron James was named the Eastern Conference Player of the Week for Week 7 (games played Monday, November 27, through Sunday, December 3), marking the first time James has won the award in 2017-18, increasing his total to an NBA-record 58 Player of the Week awards. During the Cavs' perfect 4-0 week, James posted four double-doubles and averaged 27.3 points, 8.5 rebounds, 9.0 assists, 1.8 steals and 1.0 block in 34.0 minutes.


