

Put health coverage on the **back-to-school** list

The back-to-school season is an exciting time for your children, with new activities, sports, and classmates. But it also means exposure to common childhood illnesses.

Now is the time to make sure your family has health coverage for everything from immunizations and well-child visits to emergency care. You and your children may qualify for free or low-cost health coverage based on your income.

Back-to-school checklist:

- Get school supplies
- Shop for new school clothes
- Sign up for sports and clubs
- Make sure your health coverage is up to date

- Go to **HealthCare.gov** or call **800-318-2596** (toll-free) to enroll by phone.
- The period to enroll or change health insurance plans is **Nov. 1 to Dec. 15**.
- You may qualify for free or low-cost coverage through the **Oregon Health Plan (OHP)**. You can apply for OHP at any time at **OHP.Oregon.gov**.
- **Find free, local help** from an insurance agent or community organization that can help you apply and enroll at **OregonHealthCare.gov** or by calling **855-268-3767** (toll-free) from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
