Costumes and Make-up:

All students in the show will need a costume. Some pieces will be provided by us, but most pieces will need to be found at home or purchased. I will let you know what you will need to get for your child.

All students will also need a stage make-up kit, which are around \$13-\$19 for the basic package and will last throughout the student's middle and high school career. Repeat Performance on Nicholson Lane and Gene's Costumes in Kensington have a wide assortment of theatrical make-up; most students have gotten their kits there: (301) 881-0800 (Repeat Performance), (301) 949-4111 (Gene's Costumes). Students should also purchase wedge sponges available at most CVS stores. It is not recommended that students share make-up or used sponges.
