To complete this requirement, simply access the US Dept. of Education's website: www.studentloans.gov STEP 3: Indicate the Direct Loan Amount Requested and Submit this Form: \$ Your Financial Aid Award Letter details your Direct Loan eligibility. Go to Net Partner, MLC's online financial aid portal. Log in and click on the "Awards" tab. http://mlc-wels.edu/financial-aid Accept only as much in Direct Loan funds as you need. You may borrow less than the total amount of subsidized and unsubsidized loan you are eligible for, but not more. Your loan request will be applied first toward a Subsidized Direct Loan, if you are eligible, and the balance to the Unsubsidized Direct Loan. Please note that scholarships and grants received subsequent to your award letter may result in a change in loan eligibility from subsidized to unsubsidized.
