Enrichment:

Look at numbers of personal significance- Link to ages, birthdays, house numbers

Mathematics

- Estimate how many sandwiches we would need for our wedding party-Work in small groups
- Wedding hats- Constructing with 2D shapes-Extend to 3D
- Number rhymes- '5 little pumpkins, fireworks, snowmen'
- Ordering numbers- parcels, fireworks
- Weight- Parcels look at comparing using-heavier, lighter
- Patterns- Shapes, repeating patterns etc

Provision Links

- Maths area Boxing presentsidentifying correct shaped box to use
- Play dough Wedding buffet making correct amount of buns/sandwiches etc
- o DT area-Santa's workshop/ wedding presents- Making models 3D shapes

Development

- Night time/ Road safety- Role play crossing the road. Take small groups into locality to cross roads safely to get to the park etc.

- Look at working together to create something- Turn taking, working together, problem solving.
- Encouraging children to ask for help if needed
