The next time you look at a leaf, imagine all the things that goes on in the leaf, and we can't even see it happening

The world around us is fascinating, all you have to do is look closer and take an interest to explore and understand.



Plants also give out oxygen when they make food. So plants make the oxygen that we breathe in.

Food (called sugar)
made by leaves
is sent through the stem
to all parts of the plant.

Chemical energy + Carbon dioxide = Sugar

Sugar is sent to the rest of the plant

Oxygen leaves the leaf through stomata.

Extra food is stored in the roots, stems, fruits, and seeds.



During the night plants do not make food.

In the night, plants breathe in oxygen and breathe out carbon dioxide through the stomata.

It may look like plants don't do much, but there is a lot of activity that goes on that we don't see.
