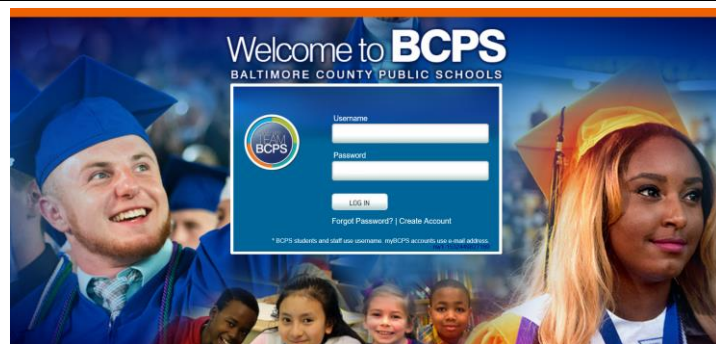
Step One

Enter your username, password, and click “LOG IN.”



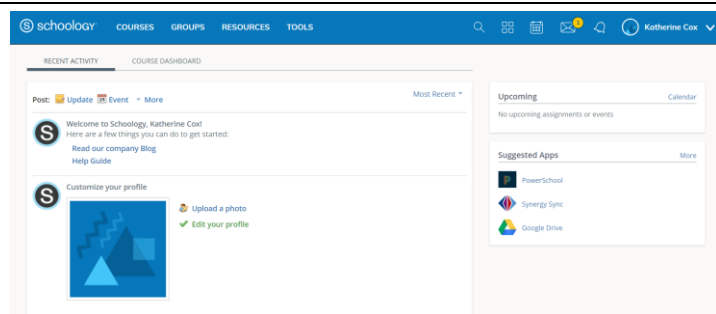
Step Three

Click the “Schoology Learning Management System” tile on the top left corner of the BCPS One splash page.






Step Four

<p>Account View</p> <p>Click on the arrow in the upper-right corner, next to your name.</p>	
<p>Connected Student Accounts</p> <p>Below your name, you'll see the name(s) of the child(ren) associated with your account.</p> <p>To view your child's activity, click the child's name from the dropdown menu.</p>	
<p>View Student Account</p> <p>The check mark in the dropdown menu indicates which account you are currently in.</p>	
<p>Student Account Activity</p> <p>Selecting your child's name will allow you to see activity in Schoology from your child's perspective.</p>
