

## Determining Computer Name and/or IP address-Windows XP

Computer Name

Left click on the **Start** button on the bottom left of the screen and right click on **My Computer**, or the desktop may have an icon that says **My Computer**, right click on it.



After Accessing My Computer click on Properties.





A window that is titled System Properties will open. Click on the one titled Computer Name.



The computer name will be found next to the **Full Computer Name** field.

From the Start menu, right-click My Network Places, and then click Properties.

To view the IP address of a wired connection, double-click Local Area Connection.

Click the **Support** tab, and then click **Details**... . The window that appears will display the IP address.
