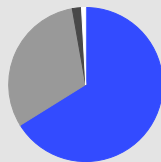

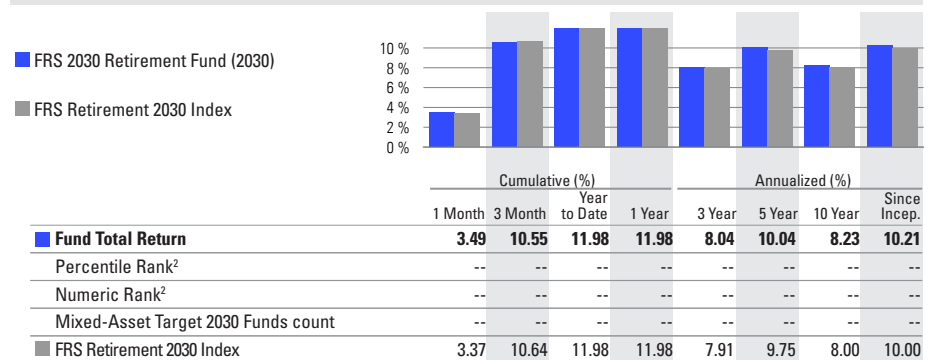

## Historical Performance (%)

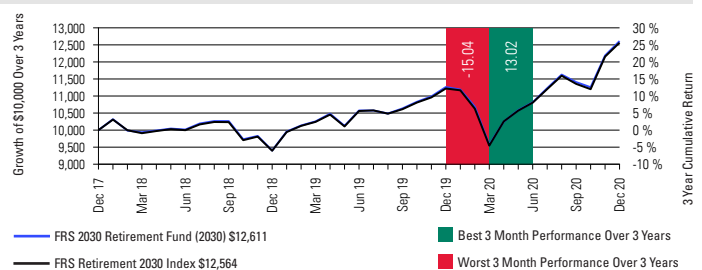

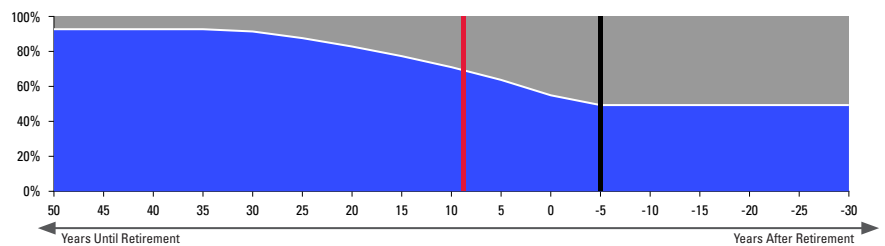

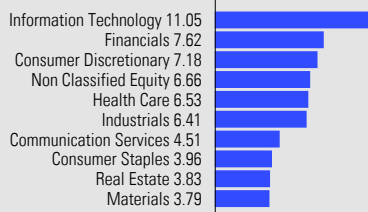

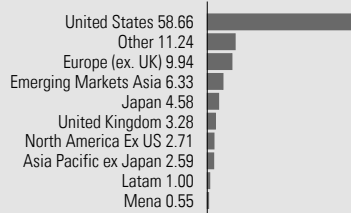
