Introduction of Behavioral Interventions and Supports Team

First, we would like to introduce you to the new **Behavioral Interventions and Supports Team** to better serve the students and families of FCPS.

Rachel Eversole has joined FCPS as the **Coordinator of Behavioral Interventions and Supports**. Rachel previously served as a Special Education Teacher for several years and then as a Coordinator of Autism and Behavior Disorders with Berkeley County Schools in West Virginia. She also previously served as a Crisis Intervention Counselor for at risk adolescent males. Ms. Eversole is a Nationally Board Certified Teacher, in the area of Exceptional Needs, and is a Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) trainer.

Four **Teacher Specialists for Behavioral Interventions and Supports** will also be members of the team.
