## **Your First Dues Reminder for 2018**

As a reminder for new and veteran members alike, we do not send out dues notices in the mail. It's costly and should be unnecessary as we all know your phoenix club membership is a subscription that end each year. We count on our membership to be intelligent enough to renew it yourselves. We begin collecting dues for the new year in October and end with the deadline which is ALWAYS the last day in February. That gives you approximately 5 months to pay your dues. Also a reminder to give your key card to no one. Not your spouse not your friend not any family member. NO ONE. Your key card belongs to you and to you alone. If your guest needs to leave the club and then come back in it is up to you to let them back in the club. Giving your key card to someone else is a violation of the BY-LAWS and is subject to penalty or membership termination

## MEMBERSIP DRIVE ON SATURDAY OCTOBER 21st

If you have a family member or friend who is interested in joining the club this would be the day to do it. For the price of a years membership you will get all of the rest of 2017 plus the full calendar year of 2018. Please take advantage of this as the Board of Directors would like to crack down on members who bring a guest in more that 3 times in the calendar year. There is a BY-Law that states if any member bring in a guest 3 times within the same calendar year that member is required to get the guest to join. This includes any quest over the age of 21 be it your friend, boyfriend, girlfriend or family member. It's up to the members to abide by the rules of the club you chose to join.

Members may also begin paying their dues for 2018 on or after the date of October 21. The 3 classifications of key cards are, Members, Spouses and Widows or Widowers cards.

**Club Elections Coming in November** I know it's still the top of September but I need to bring up the coming of elections on Wednesday November 15th. A Chairman for the nomination committee will be selected soon after which said chairperson will work on adding 6 more people to the nominating committee. The names of the committee will then be posted on the bulletin board in the bar room so that anyone who might be interested in running for one of the club positions can seek out anyone on the nominating committee to let them know of your intentions to run. Often times members get enthused about running for office and once elected do little to nothing throughout the year. If you want to be elected, please want to help. The officers and board members of the club need to be an example for the rest of the membership. This includes volunteering as well as showing up for events that we hold. Board members come to the board meeting held on the second Tuesday of each month to go over financials for the previous month. Board members are needed to give their opinions on how to save the club money and


